

#### Deacon's Blog

#### **Many Blessings:**

Some monks in Thailand were moving a large clay statue of Buddha. Their temple was being torn down to make way for a modern freeway. Suddenly the cart carrying the statue hit a pothole, cracking the statue. The monks were heartbroken. Just then however, they notice something shiny inside the crack. It was a solid gold Buddha concealed inside the clay statue. Apparently, the gold statue had been coated with clay centuries before to conceal it from invading Burmese armies. The two events that the monks' thought were catastrophes – losing their temple and having the Buddha crack open – turned out to be enormous blessings. <sup>1</sup>

In today's Gospel reading, we hear of two more blessings: the healing of Jairus' daughter; and, the healing of the woman with the hemorrhage. God desires to heal us. We can approach him as Jairus did and as the women in the crowd did. Our faith in him will allow him to give us many blessings. <sup>2</sup>




