

### The Gift of Faith:

As parents, we feel dumbfounded when we hear glowing reports about our children from teachers, coaches, or other parents. "Is that really my son or daughter or an imposter." The children's behavior at home might be different than the glowing reports.

Tears streamed down my cheeks during a frantic search for my lost wedding and anniversary rings. After an hour of lifting couch cushions and scouring every nook and cranny at our home. My husband said, "I'm sorry. We'll replace them." Later, while reaching into the pocket of a sweater worn earlier in the week, I found the priceless jewels. My reply "Thank You, Jesus!"

Sometimes, we have little faith in the glowing reports versus home environment of our kids; or, lack of faith in a moment of losing something of value. Faith is a gift from God by which we adhere to the teachings of Jesus Christ. Our own faith is our personal response to Our Lord's invitation to follow Him. 


#### JOHN PAUL II IN AMERICA: UNITING A CONTINENT





