

Tears streamed down my cheeks during a frantic search for my lost wedding and anniversary rings. After an hour of lifting couch cushions and scouring every nook and cranny at our home. My husband said, "I'm sorry. We'll replace them." Later, while reaching into the pocket of a sweater worn earlier in the week, I found the priceless jewels. My reply "Thank You, Jesus!"

Sometimes, we have little faith in the glowing reports versus home environment of our kids; or, lack of faith in a moment of losing something of value. 
FORMED NOW! CATHOLIC SPIRITUALITY AND BASEBALL


LISTEN WALKING THROUGH THE VALLEY OF THE SHADOW OF DEATH BY ADM. JEREMIAH DENTON








We are in need of a volunteer who can possibly repair our riding lawnmower.
