Spiritual Strength.

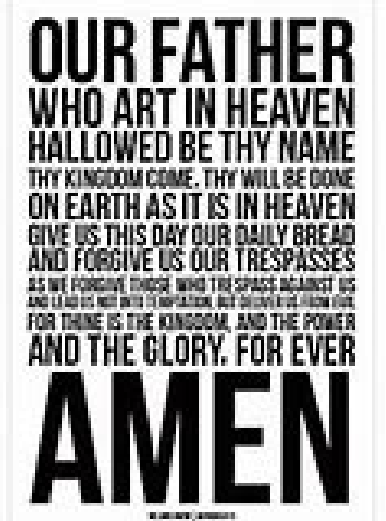

Answer can be found at Matthew 6:9-13.

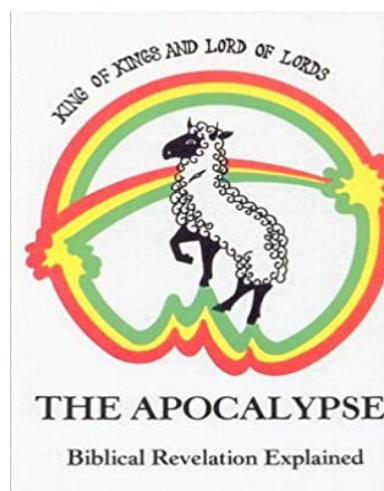

A few months ago we had a list of unexpected expenses in the bulletin. These were expenses for which we did not budget. The parishioners of Nativity came through to cover these expenses. Here is a list of items that have been repaired:

Office air conditioner	\$ 6,980
Parish hall roof	\$ 3,650
Church stucco and one roof leak	\$13,290

Current and future projects:

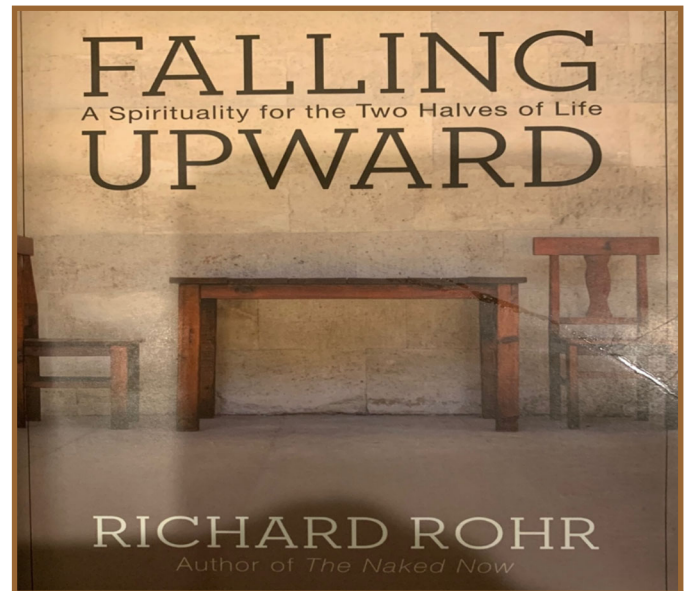
Improvements to the parish hall kitchen have begun. Some of the funds will come from what we made at the Spring Celebration, CSA, and the Building Fund.

Restriping of the church parking lot \$ 4,112

We have been informed, due to recent law, all elevators in the state of Florida need to be upgraded. The cost of this upgrade is \$42,000. I have contacted our State representative, Michelle Saltzman, about how this impacts not only small businesses, but churches, as well; however, there is no relief for us or small businesses. Nativity must upgrade our elevator in order to be in compliance with the law.

Again, Father Raymond, our staff, and I thank you all so much for your generosity. We all remember you in our daily prayers.
