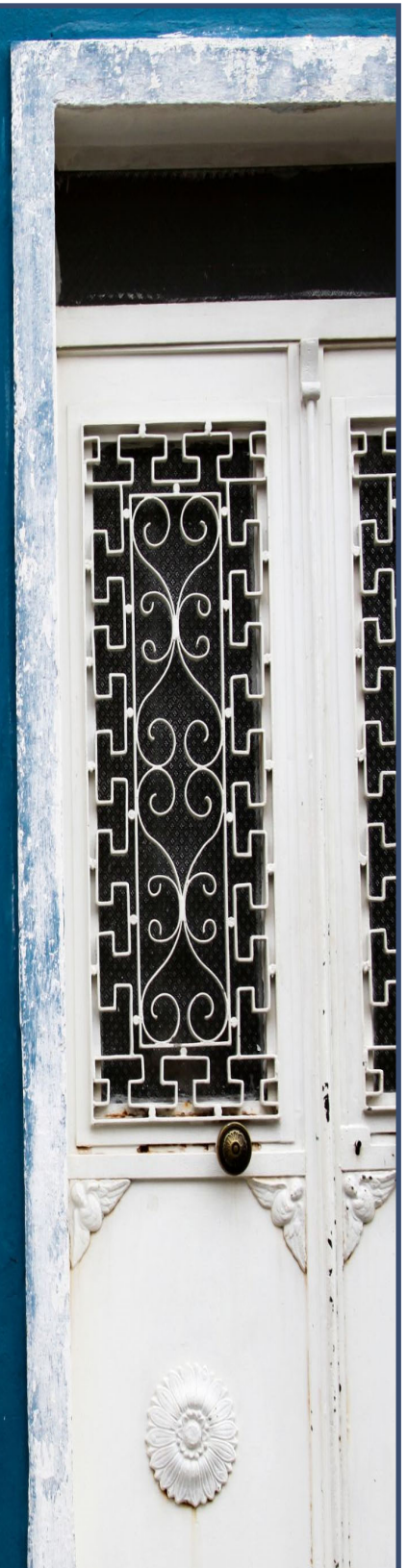

### Narrow Gate:

“How big is heaven? Is heaven full? How big is hell? We hear the familiar message from Jesus to *strive to enter through the narrow gate*. We quickly get caught up in a similar kind of speculation. Our journey as disciples of Jesus is not always easy. The challenges we face are ones the Lord will help us endure, pointing us to the narrow gate and keeping us on the road when we ask for his help.”

“Pope Francis provides an insight into how we are called to act with all the challenges that we face. One act is caring for creation. Consider how we can act in a way that ensures we are properly caring for God’s creation. When we keep this concern in focus, we align ourselves in a particular way with the narrow entrance to the kingdom.”

“Another act that Pope Francis provides is respecting life (from conception to natural death). When we look out for every life and do what we can to protect it, we find ourselves on a path toward that gate.”

“So, let’s not get distracted by our speculations. We need to place the needs of others before our own needs through compassion and sacrifice. We need to follow Jesus’ command to love the Lord with your whole heart and to love your neighbor as yourself (Luke 10:25-28).<sup>1</sup>

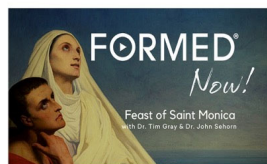

#### FORMED NOW: THE FEAST OF SAINT MONICA

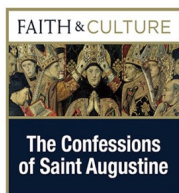

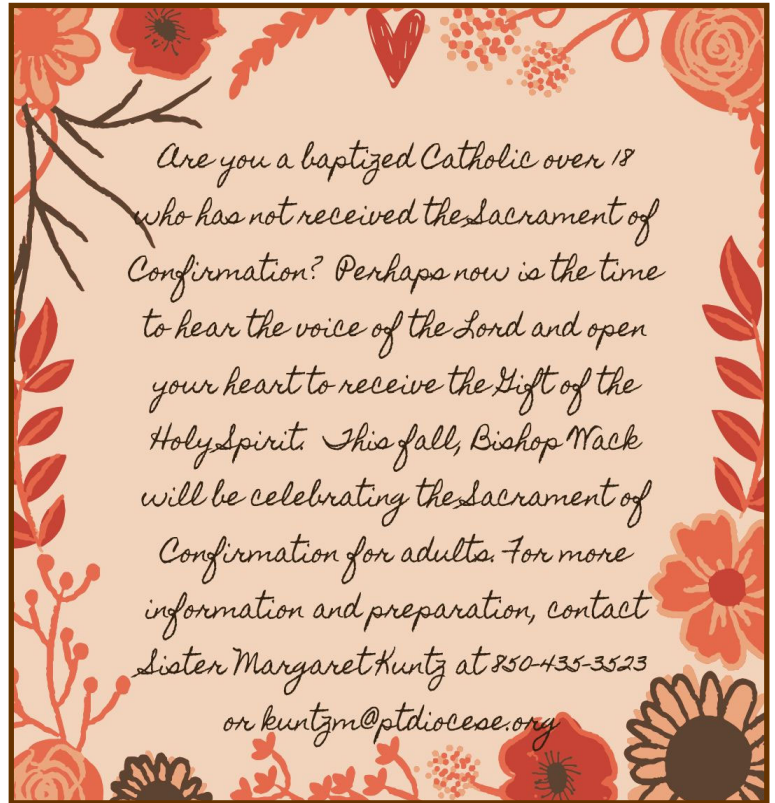

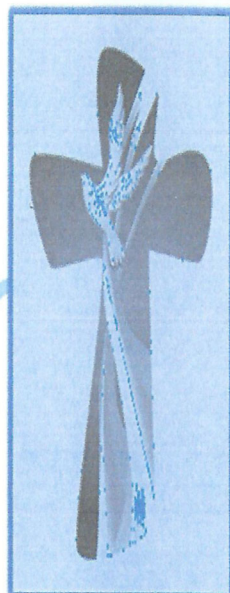
