## Patron Saint of Love



### Only the Clean of Heart:

“Every day we make choices.

We are free to choose between right and wrong, good and bad, and grace and sin. God wishes for us to do good and to have a clean heart. We have to pay attention not only to our actions, but to their roots within our inner being. Opening ourselves to God gives us the wisdom to choose wisely and to tune our hearts to God’s Word”.<sup>1</sup>

“But, I haven’t done anything wrong. I haven’t killed anyone; I haven’t cheated on my spouse. But, in reading today’s gospel, all of us are guilty of adultery and murder. Jesus says that if we are lustful or angry with others, we are guilty of these crimes and deserve to be thrown into Gehenna” (Mat. 5: 22).


“This may seem unfair, but entering into the kingdom requires a completely clean heart. Nothing impure can live in the presence of God. How can I become completely pure of heart? The short answer is, we can’t. But, God can! If we open ourselves to God’s Word, pray often, love much and yes, go to confession and the Eucharist, God will cleanse us. Then we shall become the clean of heart who see God.”<sup>2</sup>

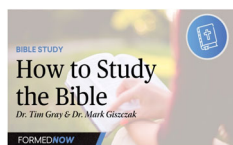

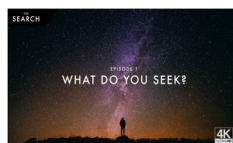

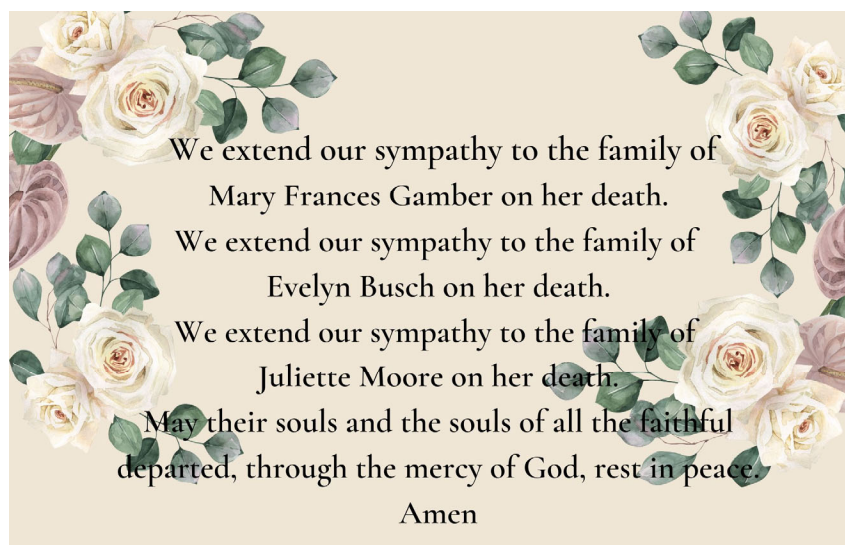
