Receiving Peace:

“There have been times in my life where I have been scared. One example was riding a roller coaster. I became scared when I would go down especially on the first steep decline. I felt like I was not in control. The next time that I rode on the roller coaster I didn’t feel quite as scared because I knew what was going to happen.”

“On our life’s journey from our birth to our death, we will experience many trials. We will be scared. In today’s Gospel, we heard that the disciples were scared. As soon as Jesus enters the room, He says ‘Peace be with you’ (JN 20:21). Jesus appeared to the disciples and breathed on them. When we hear the Scripture readings, Jesus is speaking to us with the breath of the Holy Spirit. Jesus wants to speak to us personally and powerfully through the Scriptures.”

“At every Mass, we share in the same joy of the first disciples. By the power of the Holy Spirit, we can know his voice – just as Thomas and the other disciples came to know his voice. We are encouraged to live and grow in faith on our life’s journey. We may still be scared, but take heart in knowing that Jesus offers us mercy and peace.”

“Peace be with you.”¹

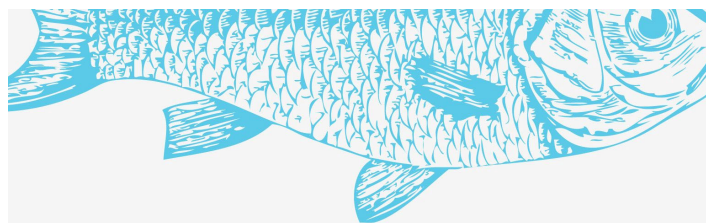


Seven Deadly Sins, Seven Lively Virtues by Bishop Robert Barron

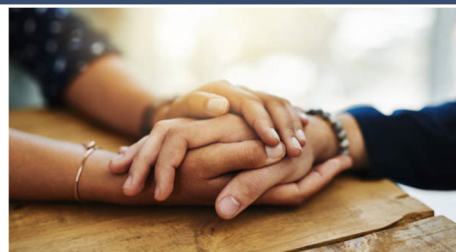
