Listening to the Holy Spirit:

"In today's first reading, we hear of the community who is struggling. The Acts of the Apostles is so realistic. It's as if we are living in a mirror image of the communities back then. People trying to fool the Apostles. People arguing to get their fair share of the food. The Church was growing."

"Previously in the Acts we were told that the early Christians shared with each other and lived in harmony. How quickly things change. Our human nature kicks in. I want this, I want that. The Hellenists complained that their daily distribution was being neglected. The Apostles find themselves having to settle a squabble between the two groups of followers."

"The solution was solved when they brought the community together to <u>listen</u> and then had them pick those who would be tasked with distributing the daily distribution. Those selected became the first deacons, and the conflict was resolved. The role of deacons filled the practical needs of the growing Church. The Apostles chose seven men filled with the Spirit. The lesson from this is: we are all sinners, but under the guidance of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, we can solve our conflicts and grow in faith. Let us truly be the body of Christ by demonstrating the Father's love to others." ¹






