Deacon's Blog

The Gift of Prayer:

"One night while watching TV, I received a phone call from my daughter. 'Dad, I'm on Interstate 65 and I don't know how to get home.' I asked her 'Tell me what mile-marker you are at.' She replied, 'I just passed mile-marker 78.' 'Just a minute, let me get on the computer.' I told her, 'At the next exit, get off the interstate, it should be exit 85. You are heading south and you should be heading north. At exit 85, cross the interstate and get back on the interstate heading north. Once you get to exit 75, you should recognize that this is Southern Blvd. You should recognize where you are.'"

"It's good to have a way to get help when we're in trouble. Someone who will answer our cries when we're trapped in a problem of our own making. The best solution is one that God gifted us – prayer. 'Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God.' But when we pray, do we speak from the height of our pride and will, or 'out of the depths' of a humble and contrite heart? He who humbles himself will be exalted; humility is the foundation of prayer. Only when we humbly acknowledge that 'we do not know how to pray as we ought,' are we ready to receive freely the gift of prayer, 'Man is a beggar before God'. "(CCC 2559).1"





Dr. Tim Gray and Dr. Ben Akers discuss the Rule of St. Benedict as it applies to daily life.




