

# Deacon's Blog

#### **Persistence:**

"Many times, when we go down a grocery aisle with our children, or grandchildren, they are persistent in wanting certain items – sugar coated cereals, chocolate M&Ms, potato chips, snack bars, cookies, etc. All of these items, to them, are great and delicious. However, when we go down the isle of canned vegetables or pasta, you do not hear a peep. After repeated persistence from the child, we give in and get them what they wanted."

"If only we could have the persistence of a child! In today's Gospel, Jesus at first seems reluctant to help the woman. She is a Canaanite, not a Jew, and he tells the Apostles he was 'sent only to the lost sheep' of Israel (Matthew 15:24). Yet, her persistence inspires his admiration of her faith, and he grants her wish: the healing of her daughter."

"Persistence in prayer is a common theme of the Gospels, a measure of faith in times of trail. Jesus encourages us to be persistent in entering his heavenly Father with our request while trusting that God's will, not ours, be done." 1

Jesus, give me the gift of persistence in prayer.






