Again, the answer was, "NO!"

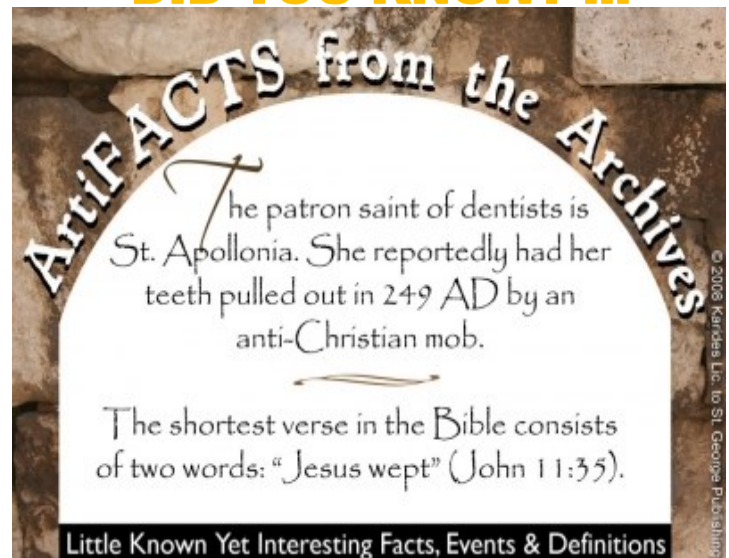
