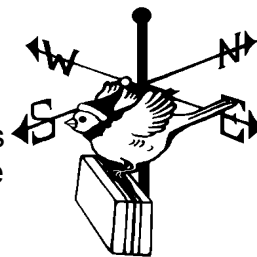

Prior to the Novena, beginning at 5:00 PM, there will be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Come and spend some quiet time with the Lord.

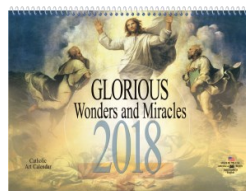
It is good that we care for one another and pray for one another. Come and join us as we raise up our sisters and brothers who carry the cross of illness.

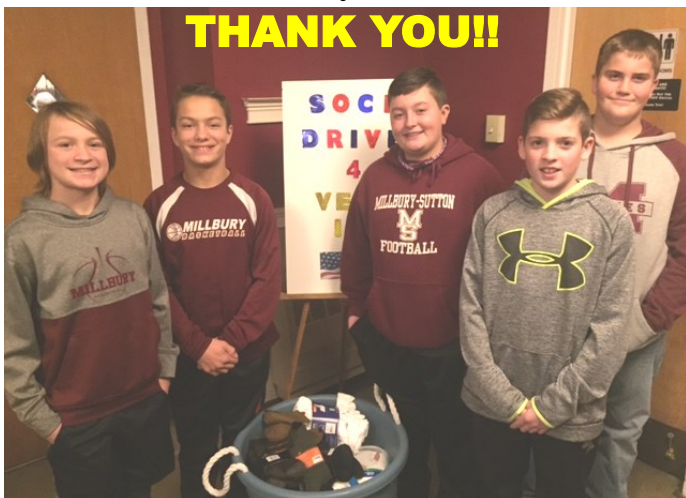
