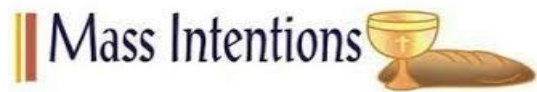

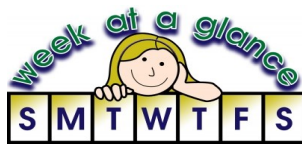

Dear Monsignor/Father,

Recently you received a progress report from Guidance in Giving, outlining the work that is taking place in preparation for our diocesan-wide Capital Campaign. Late last year, in anticipation of the Feasibility Study for this campaign, I asked that there be a moratorium on individual parish capital campaigns in order to not conflict with the diocesan capital campaign. However, I want to take this opportunity to clarify a few matters in relation to that request.

You and I both recognize that we are about to engage parishioners on three levels of giving: the regular weekly offertory collection; the annual Partners in Charity Appeal to support diocesan agencies and ongoing programs; and the Capital Campaign. It is important to keep in mind that each of these three areas of giving is different, and that giving must start with the parish offertory collection as a foundation, then Partners in Charity, and then the Capital Campaign. If a parish is not bringing in sufficient, weekly ordinary income to cover basic operational needs, then the other two fundraising efforts will not resolve ordinary parish operational expenses.

With the above in mind, I want to stress that the moratorium on individual parish capital campaigns does NOT mean a moratorium on offertory enhancement. Since we conducted Sharing our Blessings in 2010, the intention has always been to encourage parishes to conduct renewal efforts each fall in conjunction with stewardship fairs and other activities to engage parishioners.

As you work this summer on your calendar of activities for the fall, I would encourage you to include an Offertory Renewal Initiative. Step-by-step resources have been available on our diocesan website since 2013 and are still valid today (worcesterdiocese.org/sharing-our-blessings-1). Educating and encouraging a greater sense of stewardship among your parishioners will not only help with your parish operational challenges; but it will also enhance our efforts in our annual Partners in Charity appeal and the upcoming Capital Campaign.
