A LETTER TO OUR FAITH FORMATION FAMILIES

Greetings!

We are pleased to announce the opening or our Faith Formation program for the 2020-21 year. Classes will begin in November as we hope the delayed start provides a little extra "breathing room" for families to acclimate to the new school learning models.

Registration will open this coming Sunday, October 4th. Registration forms will be available to print from our parish website www.stbrigidparish.org/faith-formation. Also available on the website will be the full 2020-21 Faith Formation schedule grades 2-10. Forms and payment can be made three ways: 1) Place in collection basket at Mass beginning this weekend. 2) Drop off at Parish Office located at 59 Main St. There will be a bin marked "Faith Formation Registrations" located inside the front porch of the office. 3) Mail to: St. Brigid Parish, Attn: Faith Formation, 59 Main St., Millbury, MA 01527. Fees will be \$100 for the first child, and \$25 each additional child, with a family cap of \$150. Checks are to be made payable to "St. Brigid Parish".

As of right now, our plan is for an average of two in-person 50-60 minute sessions per grade each month. Of course, given COVID, this is a very fluid plan and will be adjusted if and when new guidelines come about. Generally speaking, the schedule will have Grades 2-4 meeting Sunday mornings, Grades 5 & 6 on Monday evenings, and 7-10 on Sunday evenings in separate parish halls. There will be three separate parent zoom meetings next week to review our plan and COVID guidelines. The links to join the meetings will be shared via email this weekend. Please make every effort for at least one parent to attend these meetings. Students need not attend.



Guidelines for Returning to Mass

Weekend Mass Schedule now through September

Saint Brigid: Saturday 4:00PM; Sunday 7:00AM & 11:00AM Our Lady of the Assumption: Sunday 9:00AM

While we return to celebrate Mass during this current reopening phase, here are some guidelines we ask that you observe at both churches:

ENTER/EXIT: Use the front doors only at both churches for entry and exit. Only in an emergency, should the nearest safe exit be used.

ACCESSIBILITY Anyone needing the accessible elevette at Assumption Church will still be able to do so via the rear hall door.

COVER UP: Masks must be worn at all times in the church except when it is time to receive Holy Communion.

SEATING: Every other pew has been taped-off closed for social distancing. In each open pew we have marked off, with stickers or tape, six feet of spacing as a point of reference. Families/Households sitting together do not need to safe distance.


WALK THIS WAY: All aisles are marked with arrows on the floor to allow for safe flow of traffic during Communion.

COMMUNION: Only the Body of Christ will be offered for the foreseeable future. Please practice six feet of social distancing at all times during communion.

SIGN OF PEACE: Please use a non-contact sign of peace with a friendly wave to those around you.

PROCESSIONS: The priest, deacon and ministers will not process via the center aisle before Mass.

SANITIZE: While we will have some hand sanitizer pump bottles accessible in both churches, we encourage all to bring their own personal size supply to Mass if possible.
