


Domestic Violence Awareness

9th Annual Celebrate Priesthood will be held from 5:30-7:30 p.m., Thursday, Oct. 20, at SAINT PAUL DIOCESAN JR./SR. High School, Worcester.

Last April Pope Francis spoke about "the joy of being a priest". It is "a joy", that is "guarded by three sisters: sister poverty, sister fidelity and sister obedience", he stated. "In a special way, old age is a time of

grace, in which the Lord renews his call to us: he calls us to safeguard and transmit the faith, he calls us to pray, especially to intercede; he calls us to be close to those in need."

Close to 55 priests are currently retired throughout our Diocese, and despite the inability for many of them to assist in parishes, they continue to care for the people of God with great zeal. Retirement for a priest means to retire from active ministry, but it does not mean to retire from priestly care for the People of God. Our retired priests continue to pray daily for special intentions. They often give their time to hear confessions and celebrate Mass in our parishes.
