





SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL PRIEST

"We should assist the poor in every way and do it both by ourselves and by enlisting the help of others.... To do this is to preach the gospel by words and work."

- Saint Vincent de Paul

Saint Vincent devoted his whole life to the service of the poor, like a Mother Teresa of the 17th century. He founded a congregation of priests for missionary work, groups of laymen to help paupers and galley-slaves, and, with \$t Louise de Marillac, the Sisters of Charity. He inspired the later foundation of the lay-run \$t Vincent de Paul Society. A man of deep faith, keen intellect, and enormous creativity, he has become known as the "The Apostle of Charity". Feast day: September 27th.
