

4th Sunday of Advent



At our local high school, a number of teachers reminded their students that class ended when the bell rang, not a few minutes beforehand. The readings remind us that God fulfilled His promise to David when Gabriel announced to Mary that she had been chosen to be the mother of Jesus. 


