Pastoral Planning Preliminary Meeting

A Proposal for the Catholic Community of Millbury:

Whereas the Catholic Parishes of Millbury, St. Brigid and Our Lady of the Assumption, have been functioning, for all intents and purposes, over the last dozen or so years, as one faith community, served by one pastoral staff and a joined Finance Committee, and in light of the fact that Assumption could no longer function as a stand-alone parish supporting a pastor and staff, I would propose that the parishes be merged in whatever way is deemed most beneficial to the Catholic people of Millbury. What we are proposing would be for financial purposes mainly so that in future, one set of books could be kept, one budget set and operated rather than trying (unsuccessfully) to split costs 75% (St. Brigid) 25% (Assumption), an effort that has created unnecessary rivalries and divisions.

There is no plan to close either one of our churches, nor to sell any of the two buildings at the St. Brigid campus (church/hall, offices/rectory) or the four buildings at the Assumption campus (church/hall, rectory, school, Mary's House/former convent).

The proposal also does not envision a name change for the merged entity but rather to keep the two names of St. Brigid and Our Lady of the Assumption, honoring the legacies of both parishes and respecting the sensitivities of the parishioners of today.



Recent Relevant History:

Seemingly, our Diocese has been moving in such a direction regarding the Church in Millbury for a number of years now. Fr. Paul LaPalme was appointed pastor of St. Brigid around 2006. Fr. Richard Fortin continued to serve as pastor at Assumption where he had served for a number of years. In 2010, Fr. Donald Ouellette was appointed associate at St. Brigid and shared with St. Peter's in Worcester, an arrangement that soon proved unworkable and Fr. Don became full-time associate at St. Brigid for the next year and a half.

Meanwhile, in 2011, Fr. Fortin retired and Fr. LaPalme was appointed pastor at Assumption while continuing as pastor also of St. Brigid. Fr. Paul let members of his staff know that he was given a mandate from the diocese to evaluate the situation in Millbury and recommend which church, if any, should be closed. Fr. Paul decided it would be prudent to move his living quarters to the Assumption rectory to give some assurance to Assumption parishioners that their church was not closing. At this time, Fr. Paul also became more heavily involved at Assumption School, serving as the school's de facto "Headmaster". During the years of Fr. Paul's administration of both parishes, he viewed the parishes as "One Community", though the parishes were never formally twinned or merged. To that end, on or about 2012, the parishes kept one set of financial books and one budget for a brief time until diocesan officials intervened and discontinued the practice.

In 2014, Fr. Daniel Mulcahy became pastor of both parishes in Millbury and continues in that role to the present. The philosophy of one Catholic Community in Millbury has continued in his administration. We refer to ourselves as the Catholic Parishes of Millbury. We have one pastor, one Deacon, one Maintenance person, one Administrative Assistant, one Bookkeeper, one Religious Education Program, one Director of Music, one Choir, one Finance Committee, one Pastoral Associate/Religious Ed. Director, one Youth Minister/Religious Ed. Leader. We share our liturgies, our Faith Formation, our planning, our gatherings to break bread in celebration, our joys and our losses, and we do all of this utilizing ALL of the facilities and buildings of both our campuses. Our parishes are married one to another in all things ... but finances, and this last area is just impractical and unprofitable, spiritually and temporally, to remain the case.

"Ut Unum Sint" ... that they may be one!



Important Parish Meetings

In our Diocese of Worcester, there is an Office of Pastoral Planning which is charged with structuring the parishes, missions, and agencies of the diocese to best meet the needs of the mission of the Church to serve the People of God.

Over the past couple of years, your pastor, your deacon, and members of your Finance Committee have been meeting with diocesan officials, including Bishop McManus, about the situation of our two parishes in Millbury and whether it might be spiritually and financially beneficial for the two to become one parish. There would be no closings, no big name changes, no difference in parish operations; the two parishes would simply become one parish with one set of books, one budget.

As you read these explanatory articles from the pastor in the bulletin over this month of February, we invite you to think it over and, hopefully, come to see the wisdom and benefit of such a change.

Members of our Diocesan Pastoral Planning Commission will be with us in Millbury on two occasions for open meetings to facilitate discussion, answer questions, and listen to any concerns that might be raised. Those meetings will be:

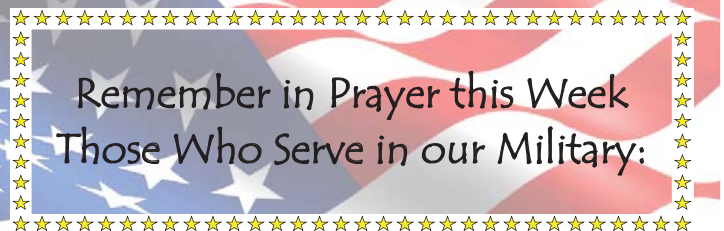
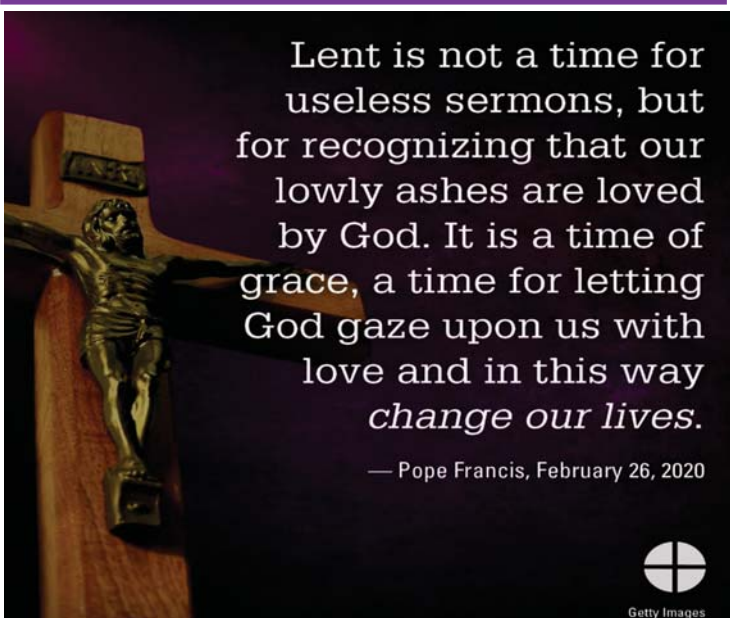

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.
