





Being Like Little Children

That's what Jesus taught the apostles. In Matthew 18, it is written that the apostles argue about which one of them was the greatest. And what does Jesus say "Amen, I say to you, unless you become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven. Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven." Then again Jesus must reiterate this point when the apostles try to prevent the children from bothering Jesus, but Jesus says, "Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

Let us pray: Lord, grant us the humility of knowing our littleness, our youth, and our dependence on you. And grant us the joy and peace of giving ourselves to your Father and Mother, so that we may fully rest in their love. Amen!
