

## Trinity Sunday

Picture this: It is Christmas morning and there is a pile of toys that need assembly. Do you read the directions first, or just pull everything out of the box and see what you can do with it? Do you use the picture on the box as a guide, or do you just imagine the toy and put it together as you see it in your mind? The goal helps us decide what is necessary to reach it.

Our understanding of faith and our reflection on the great mysteries of the last few weeks deepen our awareness of God's presence and majesty in our life. If God is the goal, then we measure everything we say and do, every choice and decision, by how it affects us in achieving that goal. The more mindful we are of God in our life, the more likely we are to make decisions that help rather than hinder our relationship with Him.

So what really guides and directs our life? We learn from the values and ideals we label as important and we should be different because of our beliefs. If they are genuine, they are more than convenient sound bites that make us feel better about ourselves. They are the core of who we are, what we do, and who we will become. Choose your goal carefully and the direction of your life will follow the course you set.




