## Apostles Peter and Paul

hese apostles share a feast as founders of the church in Rome. Peter, a Galilean fisherman chosen by Christ as on of the Twelve Apostles, became the undisputed leader of the fledgling church after Pentecost. Paul, a Pharisee and Roman citizen who had persecuted Christians, became after his dramatic conversion the church's greatest missionary, its "apostle of the gentiles." By tradition both were martyred in Rome. Their adventures are recounted in the Acts of the Apostles, and letters from them are included in the New Testament.



#### Love your Enemies

I just listened to a podcast by Dr, Mike Scherschligt, about loving your enemies. Now you might be thinking, "I don't have anyone in my life who is my enemy, I mean, sure there may be people who don't like me, but that doesn't make them my enemy". That's true, but nearly everyone has someone they secretly resent. You have kind of made them your enemy. Now here is the big one, an enemy is not just the person who fights me or bullies me, but the person I refuse to love because I resent them. WOAH! Let's think about this a minute. We tend to resent those who have hurt, failed or disappointed us. This could be family, friends, co-workers or classmates. In this way, you become my enemy, not necessarily through open conflict, but by the interior judgement I hold against you. WOW! Deep down, even without knowing it we feel and begin to think, "Because you failed me, I must not be worth loving." Resentment is like drinking poison and hoping the other person dies.

The only way out is to find identity in God and release others through forgiveness and mercy. Forgiveness is not saying the wrong didn't happen but releases the impossible debt we placed on them. This is freedom, I need nothing from them, and I am free to love, especially my enemies. Amen.



Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul

Acts 12:1–11 Psalm 34:2–9 2 Timothy 4:6–8, 17–18 Matthew 16:13–19

This Sunday's celebration of the great apostles Peter and Paul is a celebration of the Church. Peter's deliverance from jail is compared to the deliverance of Israel from Egypt. Like Israel he is rescued at Passover from "the hand" of his enemy by an "angel of the Lord" after girding himself with belt, sandals, and cloak (see Ex 3:8; 12:8, 11–12; 14:19).

The Church is, as Peter says, "all that the Jewish people had been expecting." As he affirms in his great confession of faith in Sunday's Gospel, Jesus is "the Christ," the Messiah that the prophets had taught Israel to hope for.

But Christ is more than what the Jewish people had been hoping for.

He is the Christ. But He is also, as Peter confesses, "the Son of the living God." Born of the flesh of the Jewish people, he is a son of Abraham and David (see Mt 1:1; Rm 1:3). Through Him and the Church founded on the rock of Peter's faith, God fulfills the promise he made to Abraham—to bless all nations in his seed (see Gen 22:18).

What Christ calls "my Church," is the new Israel, the kingdom of God, the family made up of all peoples—Jews and Gentiles—who believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God (see Gal 3:26–29; 6:16). And we must make this confession our own. Jesus' question, "Who do you say that I am?" is addressed to each of us personally.

We must confess our faith in Christ not only with our tongues, but with our lives. As Paul describes his discipleship in this week's Epistle, we must make our lives an oblation, an offering of love for the sake of Jesus and His kingdom (see Rm 12:1).

We know, as we sing in this week's Psalm, that the Lord has rescued us in Christ Jesus. We know that he will stand by us, giving us strength to face every evil—and that He will bring us to the heavenly kingdom we anticipate in this Eucharist.
