Reconciliation

When they persisted in asking Him, He straightened up and said to them, "He who is without sin among you, let him be the first to throw a stone at her." (John 8:7) Jesus also said on the Mount, "Why do you observe the splinter in your brother's eye and never notice the plank in your own? How dare you say of your brother, 'Let me take the splinter out of your eye', when all the time there is a plank in your own? Hypocrite! Take the plank out of your own eye first, and then you will see clearly enough to take the splinter out of your brother's eye".

Pride makes us blind to our own moral defects. Humility makes us see. To be able to see clearly, first you must place yourself in God's presence. Begin with prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to shows you your sins. Entrust yourself to Mary, Mirror of Justice, to help you see without self-deception. Then start to review the 10 Commandments and Precepts of the Church to name clear external sins. Now the Holy Spirit has prepared you to receive the healing, forgiveness, and grace that can only come from Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

When we go to Confession, Jesus forgives our sins and removes the guilt that separates us from God, restoring our friendship with Him. Amen!




