B orn near Lyon, France, this farmer's son studied for the priesthood for many years, and eventually was ordained more for his devoutness and good will than for other qualities. But he became a model parish priest in Arsen-Dombes, where he served for 40 years. He was devoted to his parishioners, and became famous for rigorous preaching and insights in the confessional. The Cure of Ars, as he was known, spent up to 18 hours a day hearing the confessions of pilgrims who sought him out. He is the patron of parish priests.

The Society of the Propagation of the Faith, the Mission Office of the Church invites our United States parishes to welcome a missionary for one weekend each summer.

Next weekend we are happy to welcome Sr. Lucy Peter Mshami of the Sisters of Our Lady of Usambara Tanga-Tanzania, Africa to speak of the congregation's work for the People of God.

The Sisters of Our Lady of Usambara is a growing congregation of over 600 African nuns, whose work is caring for the poor and most deprived people in the northeastern region of Tanzania.

Their area of ministries includes but not limited, teaching religious education to young people, providing services to the poor and the sick, and providing education in schools and colleges.

The Sisters also provide food and shelter to the poor and needy people and food and education to orphans/helpless children who have lost their parents to the malaria endemic,

HIV/AIDs and other killer diseases.

This ministry, which provides medical services to people of all ages, has a serious shortage of medication and no or poor medical equipment, leading to a high number of deaths.

St. Joseph Health center which serves a large community is in the region where electric outages are a serious problem, threatening lives especially during surgical procedures.

The shortage/complete lack of water is a serious problem. Students go for days without water, forcing them to walk for miles to collect water. There is also a great demand for food, clothing and shelter. The Sisters understand difficulties, problems and opportunities within the community they serve. The problem is the shortage of resources to serve people.
