FAITH FORMATION



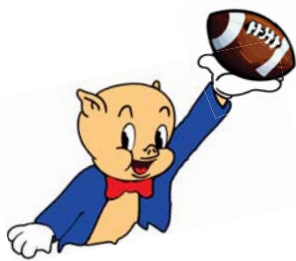
Registration for our 2025-2026 Faith Formation Program will take place in August for all grades. Complete registration details can be found in the bulletin and website in mid-July.

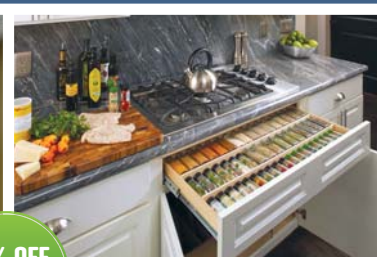

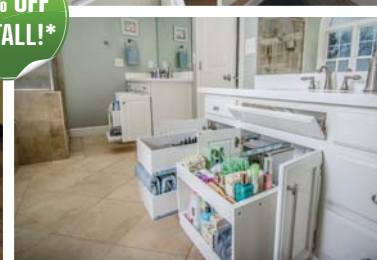
