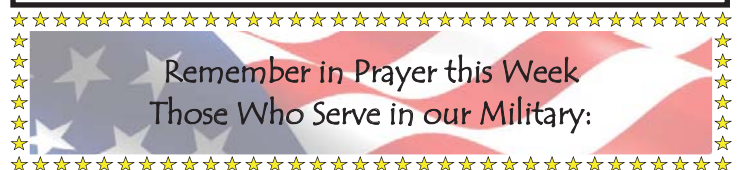

Volunteer opportunities are available at their Emergency Services offices in various locations as well as at their Family Shelter & Mercy Centre.

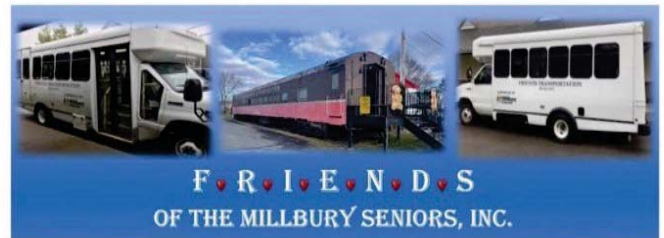
Volunteers assist with food & clothing distribution, organizing donations, stocking shelves, preparing meals & helping with children's activities.

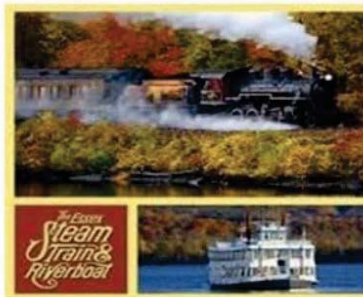

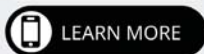
