Dear Presentation People,

As we conclude autumn and approach winter, our hearts are filled with deep gratitude—for all that has been, all that is, and all that is yet to come. Together, as vowed women religious, associate ministers and partners in mission, we believe that “we have been created for this very moment” (Esther 4:14).

This moment continues to call us to live the Gospel values of hope, justice, peace and care for Earth and one another. 

Walking in the Footsteps of Nano

- June 2, 2025** Arrival in Dublin, Rock of Cashel, travel to Cork
- June 3, 2025** Footsteps of Nano in Cork, St. Fin Barre's Cathedral, Nano Nagle Place, Nano's gravesite, St. Finbarr's South Chapel
- June 4, 2025** Nano's birthplace (Ballygriffin), Blarney Castle
- June 5, 2025** Ring of Kerry, Kenmare, Muckcross House, Killarney (Presentation school opened in 1793 as the first foundation outside of Cork)
- June 6, 2025** Bunratty Castle, Cliffs of Moher, Tuam (Mother Aloysius came to New York from here in 1874)
- June 7, 2025** Kylemore Abbey, Galway (convent opened here in 1815), Mass at Cathedral of the Assumption (next to Presentation convent)
- June 8, 2025** Clonmacnoise, Dublin tour, Book of Kells and Trinity College, Merry Ploughboy

Honoring our Jubilarians

Serving with Compassion, Determination and Grace



Bronx native Sister Noreen (Mary Richard) Perelli was inspired to join the Presentation congregation by her cousin, Sister Mary Dominic Devery. After graduating from St. Michael's Academy in Manhattan, she entered religious life and went on to teach for 30 years in New Jersey and New York.

Her ministry expanded at John S. Burke High School in Goshen, where she managed audio-visuals and earned her Ham radio license to stay connected with sisters serving in Peru.

For 18 years, Noreen served seniors and the homebound at Immaculate Conception Parish in the Bronx, offering comfort through visits and phone calls. "For many elderly, life can be very lonely," she says. "My contact is important."

Now living in the last Presentation house in New York City, she treasures community life, daily prayer and Eucharist with her sisters. After retiring in 2011, she briefly represented the congregation at the United Nations and continues to minister as a pastoral visitor.

In her quieter moments, Noreen enjoys puzzles, prayer and tending a summer vegetable garden—simple joys that reflect a life rooted in faith and service.



Sister Paula (Mary Paula) Cormier first sensed a calling to religious life in elementary school in Fitchburg, Massachusetts. Life took her in other directions, but a chance encounter with a vowed sister after high school reignited that call. That fall, she entered the convent.

Her early years as a teacher laid the foundation for a lifetime of service, including 12 transformative years as a missionary in Sicuani, Peru. "Living in a different culture opened my eyes," she says. "God uses so many ways to teach us what he wants us to learn."

Back in the Diocese of Worcester, Paula poured her energy into the Spanish Apostolate and served communities in Southbridge and Clinton. She also ministered at the Hispanic Catholic Center in Newburgh, New York.

Over the years, Sister served the congregation in leadership and as novice director. She later brought her compassionate heart to pastoral care and parish outreach work. Now living at Notre Dame du Lac, she continues teaching ESL and recently helped launch a community garden project.

Through it all, Paula sees God's presence and a call to hope. "We don't have the luxury of giving up. God has brought us here for a purpose and we must live it."



The youngest of four children from Manhattan, Sister Kathleen (Mary Stephanie) Cusack first felt her calling at St. Michael's High School, inspired by the sisters' love for each other and their dedication to students.

Over decades, she taught elementary grades, English and history, including six memorable years at St. Lucy's in Louisiana, and later served as a librarian at several schools. Her heart led her back to St. Michael's where she served for 22 years as a high school principal, a time filled with joy, growth and the challenges of 9/11.

Reflecting on her many years in education ministry, she shares, "I deeply cherish teaching reading to little ones, introducing literature and history, and helping teens believe in themselves."

Before retiring, Kathleen returned to the library, serving at St. Joseph Seminary and St. Raymond Elementary School. She sums up her life with gratitude:

"I have been blessed with wonderful ministry experiences and the kindness of so many sisters."



Sister Mary Anne (Felice Ann) Seliga first met the Presentation Sisters while attending St. Leo's Elementary and St. Bernard's High School. Answering God's call, she entered the congregation in Fitchburg, Massachusetts, in 1955.

A devoted educator in Massachusetts and Rhode Island, Mary Anne found great joy in teaching and later in serving as a librarian. "Teaching children was a wonderful experience," she recalls. "I especially loved reading to the younger children." She also brought Scripture to life for her students through traditions like a Living Passion Play during Holy Week—an annual practice that continues today.

Beyond the classroom, Mary Anne coordinated the congregation's former retreat facility, Camp Joy, and later served as administrator at Presentation Convent in Leominster.

Now living at Notre Dame du Lac, she reflects with gratitude on her 70 years of vowed life, cherishing her prayer, community and the beauty of God's presence each day.



Sister Barbara King's first encounter with the Presentation Sisters was through attending St. Michael's High School in Manhattan. She quickly came to admire their kindness and dedication. "My time at St. Michael's was one of the best periods of my life," she says. "The sisters were remarkable women who truly lived their faith."

Drawn to their joyful sense of community, Barbara entered the congregation at 17, during the time of Vatican II. She began her ministry as a teacher, finding mentors among the sisters with whom she lived. After several school assignments, she found her long-term home at St. Rose of Lima in Rockaway Beach, where she taught for 32 years.

Elected to congregational leadership in 2009, Barbara discovered a renewed passion for justice and a broader sense of community through connecting with Presentation sisters around the world.

Today, she continues her ministry of visiting and advocating for sisters at Cabrini Nursing Home, helping them stay connected and celebrated. In her free time, she enjoys reading, cheering on the Yankees and cherishing memories of her recent pilgrimage to Ireland — "one of the highlights of my life."



Born in New York City, Sister Barbara Muldoon moved with her Irish immigrant parents to a quiet village west of Newburgh at a young age. She grew up as the only child in her class with immigrant parents, a difference that shaped her identity.

Although she attended Catholic schools, she hadn't considered becoming a sister until a high school retreat sparked the thought: Maybe God is calling me. Encouraged by a sister's advice, she visited Mount St. Joseph and entered the convent, finding a home immediately. Her Irish Catholic parents, though surprised, embraced her choice.

Barbara knew her calling was teaching. Entering during the transformative years of Vatican II, she embraced change and independence. Beyond the classroom, she served as ministry coordinator and was on the congregation's leadership team. She also enriched her perspective through diverse ministry experiences, including work at St. Rita's Center for Immigrant and Refugee Services, a part of Tolentine-Zeiser Community Life Center in the Bronx.

Barbara shares, "Religious life has been deeply rewarding. My sisters' faith sustains me." Today, living in a nursing home, she continues to serve those around her—living a life rooted in faith and compassion.

In a time when so many in our country and world are struggling, our congregation and its partners continue to find meaningful ways to respond with compassion, creativity, and hope.

Nano's Helping Hands, a newly formed ministry effort, grew out of that spirit of service. Inspired by Nano Nagle's legacy of love in action, associates began reaching out to families and individuals living in hotels in the Newburgh area, providing groceries and essential food items. What started as a simple idea has become a tangible expression of care—meeting people where they are, with dignity and kindness.

In Massachusetts, associates continue to embody that same spirit of generosity. At each monthly gathering, they bring donations for local food pantries connected to parishes where the Presentation Sisters once ministered. Their support also extends to organizations such as Care Net, which provides vital services to families in need. These small yet steady acts of giving keep the mission alive in everyday ways.

Our sisters, associates and staff have also joined together to support Fearless!, an organization dedicated to building a society where all can live free from abuse, exploitation and oppression. By partnering with Fearless!, we affirm our commitment to advocate for and accompany women and children seeking safety and hope.

Through each of these efforts—large and small—we continue to carry forward the Presentation mission: to respond to the needs of the times, to walk with the vulnerable and to shine the light of compassion wherever it is most needed.

What began as casual conversations among leaders from religious congregations has blossomed into a meaningful and evolving collaboration among several religious communities in the Hudson Valley. In 2022, seven different congregations in the Hudson Valley began meeting. Early discussions centered on shared experiences of leadership, congregational charisms and the realities of religious life today.

As the bonds deepened, the group began to explore areas of common concern: the challenges of aging memberships, the duplication of services and the shared desire to ensure the vitality of religious life into the future. Through ongoing dialogue and trust, common values began to emerge. Among them was a deep commitment to presence, to one another and to the world, as congregations continue to evolve and age. The sisters also affirmed the importance of relationships, especially as fewer are engaged in active ministries, and embraced a renewed focus on being, recognizing that presence itself is a form of ministry and gift to the world.

Faithfulness to the vow of poverty was also named as a core value, encompassing both simplicity of life and acceptance of the changes that come with aging. The long-held commitment to social justice remains central, though expressed today in new and creative ways. And while many sisters once held leadership roles in schools, health care and social service institutions, they continue to value having a voice at the table, offering wisdom and perspective grounded in Gospel values.

This spirit of collaboration has led to concrete steps forward. Several members of the congregations were introduced to their new form of living in assisted living and skilled care facilities. These moves were part of the work of early collaboration. To date, four congregations comprise the Hudson Valley Religious Collaborative. These four groups have jointly hired, Michele Pollock, a chief operating officer. Under Michele's leadership, collaboration now extends into areas like health care and pastoral services, ensuring that sisters receive compassionate and competent care while leadership teams focus on their canonical responsibilities.

The congregations acknowledge the vital role of their lay colleagues, many of whom now hold positions once filled by sisters. Their professionalism, dedication and shared commitment to mission make it possible for the congregations to continue their work and witness in the world. A recent staff meeting of the finance, health care and development departments of each congregation came together to look at sharing best practices, areas of challenge and ways of collaboration in the future.

What is emerging through the Hudson Valley Religious Collaborative is more than an administrative partnership; it is a living witness of unity in diversity. Though each congregation maintains its unique charism and governance, together they are modeling a way forward for religious life: one rooted in trust, mutual respect and faith in the future.

Sister Mary Catherine Redmond summarizes, "This venture is a witness to our Church, our country and our world that we can be different yet deeply united in our shared baptismal call."
