

When the disciples approached Jesus with the heartfelt request, "Lord, teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1), He gifted them the Our Father—a prayer that unites believers across time and space. This moment in the Gospel reveals prayer as both a personal

and communal act, a foundation for our spiritual lives. As our parish embraces prayer as its theme for the upcoming year, we are invited to deepen our relationship with God through the shared experiences of the Eucharist, Holy Hour, Rosary and every other devotional prayers within our parish community and at homes.

The Eucharist is the heart of our faith, where we gather as a parish to encounter Christ's sacrifice and presence. In the Mass, we join in the ultimate prayer of thanksgiving, offering our lives alongside Christ's offering to the Father. This communal worship binds us together, as we lift our voices in praise, confess our sins, and receive the Bread of Life. The Eucharist teaches us to pray as Jesus did—with trust, humility, and surrender to God's will, as expressed in the Our Father's plea, "Thy kingdom come." To grow in prayer through the Eucharist, we can approach Mass with intention. Arriving early to prepare our hearts, actively listening to the readings, and staying afterward in gratitude can transform our experience.

Eucharistic Adoration on Tuesdays invite us into a profound encounter with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. In silence we allow ourselves to rest in God's presence, offering adoration, contrition, thanksgiving, and petitions. When we gather as a parish for Holy Hour, we strengthen our communal bond, supporting one another in prayer and reflection. Incorporating scripture, hymns, or the Rosary into Holy Hour can deepen our experience. Devotional prayers like the Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, or Stations of the Cross in Lent connect us to the rich traditions of the Church. When prayed together, these devotions foster a sense of belonging and shared purpose. They allow us to intercede for the needs of our parish and the world, echoing the communal spirit of the Our Father. As we embark on this year dedicated to prayer, let

us follow the disciples' example by seeking to learn from Jesus. Through the Eucharist, Holy Hour, and devotional prayers, our parish community can grow closer to God and one another. These shared moments of prayer not only deepen our faith but also transform our parish into a beacon of hope and love.



St. Michael the Archangel Prayer



Church tradition, Scripture (specifically Revelation 12:7-9), and liturgy recognize St. Michael as:

- Leader of the heavenly hosts in the battle against Satan
- Protector of the Church and souls
- Guide of the departed to judgement

The St. Michael prayer, written by Pope Leo XIII in 1886 after a mystical experience, is a powerful appeal for spiritual protection. Once recited universally after Mass and later reemphasized by Pope St. John Paul II, the prayer's strength comes from its direct call for divine help and its enduring message of faith in the battle between good and evil.

Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Once I went to a hospice facility to celebrate Last Rites for an elderly dying man. His family had told me that he had been uncommunicative for days. At the conclusion of the ritual, we began to recite the Our Father prayer. To everyone's surprise, his lips moved, clearly mouthing the words to the Lord's prayer. Stripped of most of his faculties, the man could still pray those precious Godgiven petitions. A lifetime of prayer had planted the words even deeper than his failing consciousness.

Do we want the Lord's prayer to be as deeply embedded in us? If we want to be people of hope, we should. Recall that our Lord immediately follows the prayer by saying: "Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you" (Luke 11:9). We only ask, search and knock because we hope that the request is not in vain. Everything we could possibly hope for is contained in the prayer. Praying the Our Father deepens our hope.

We should consciously pour all our hopes into the Lord's prayer; we should allow it to be an expression of hope, not simply rote words. Then, over time, it builds up our hope in God. It sinks deep into our souls and bodies. How blessed we are when these words of hope are on our lips, even when everything else seems to fail.


