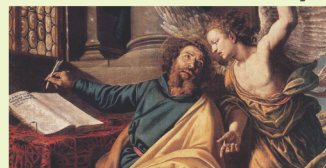

Prayer of the Week

St. Matthew & His Prayer Life



Feast Day:

September 21

St. Matthew's journey is one of the most striking transformations in the Gospels. Once a tax collector named Levi, an outsider in his own community, he was suddenly called by Jesus and didn't hesitate. That moment of radical obedience marked the beginning of a life steeped in prayer, mercy, and mission. As the author of the first Gospel, Matthew's words reflect a heart shaped by repentance and a deep desire to share Christ's message. His prayer life likely mirrored this: bold, compassionate, and always seeking spiritual growth. Today, he's celebrated as the patron saint of accountants, bankers, and those with financial hardships—proof that even the most unlikely lives can be rewritten by grace.

Key aspects of St. Matthew's prayer life:

Prompt Obedience: Matthew's immediate response to Jesus' call reflects a prayer life rooted in attentive listening and active surrender to God's will.

Mercy and Compassion: His encounter with Christ and defense against the Pharisees show a heart attuned to divine mercy—likely mirrored in his prayers for forgiveness and healing.

Evangelization: As an apostle and Gospel writer, Matthew's prayer life was outward-facing, seeking grace to proclaim Christ and open hearts to the truth.

Spiritual Growth: His dramatic conversion suggests a life of ongoing prayerful transformation, striving to grow in holiness and discipleship.

Intercession: Tradition holds that St. Matthew continues to intercede for the faithful, highlighting the enduring power of prayer for others in his legacy.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Before I was a priest, I was a lazy worker for a retail Apple store. Hearing a rumor that my boss was going to fire me, I secretly sold iPhones for half-price, gave away dozens of free iPads, and donated several brand-new laptops to managers in other stores in the mall. After a week, my boss called me into his office. He knew what I was up to. He said I had cost the store thousands of dollars. "Really great work, John," he said. "I am going to recommend you to be my assistant manager and double your pay." I was amazed.

And so are you. Which is understandable because it never happened. How could it? My tall tale is a retelling of Jesus' brow-furrowing parable we hear this week. A lazy, dishonest steward defrauds his boss and then the **"master commended the dishonest servant for acting prudently"** (Luke 16:8). What is the Lord saying to us?

Most of us treat our spiritual lives like a lazy teenager at an Apple store. We really don't care. We go through the motions. Then, if we are lucky, something happens that shakes us to spiritual action; to employ whatever time, money, and resources we have to build around us a strong network of love. Every saint did that. Our Lord is so good he *wants* us to use his stuff to forgive debts and to bless others. He wants us to ensure our future. So do it!

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Recently, Pope Leo spoke to seminarians who had gathered from all around the world for the Jubilee. He invited them to be witnesses of hope. Indeed, the men who are preparing for ordination in the Archdiocese of Chicago are witnesses of hope to us. In the future, they will serve our children, grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Some of our seminarians are in the pre-seminary spiritual year at Bishop Quarter House in the city. Others are completing their college studies at the University of St. Thomas in Saint Paul, Minnesota. Finally, those in the last four-year phase of preparation are being formed at Mundelein Seminary.

Supporting vocations to the priesthood is a task that belongs to all of us in the Church. I want to invite you to express that support in four ways:

- Pray for vocations and our seminarians in preparation
- Encourage those seminarians serving in your parish
- Urge young men to give their lives in service as priests, and
- Make a financial contribution to support our programs of priestly formation.

Prayer, encouragement, recruiting and financial support—all these actions express our gratitude to God for the gift of priestly ministry. These actions also build for the future of our Church and for our children and grandchildren. I would note that given that our seminarians need to invest themselves totally in formation, they are not able to work. Thus, it is up to us to cover the costs not only for their education but other expenses such as health insurance and other personal support.
