



As we light the second candle on our Advent wreath this Sunday, the soft glow reminds us of something both beautiful and sobering: time is slipping away. Each flame marks the swift passage of days, drawing us closer to the great feast of Christmas and, ultimately, to the return of our Savior in glory. Advent is never merely a countdown to December 25; it is an intense season of preparation, a sacred time when the Church invites us to make room in our hearts for the One who is coming.

The readings this weekend, especially the majestic words of the prophet Isaiah, thunder with hope: “A voice cries out: In the desert prepare the way of the LORD! Make straight in the wasteland a highway for our God!” (Is 40:3). For centuries the people of Israel listened to these promises and waited. Today, we listen again, knowing that the Messiah has already come in the humility of Bethlehem and will come again in glory. The hymns we sing—“O Come, O Come, Emmanuel,” “On Jordan’s Bank,” “People, Look East”—are not background music for shopping malls; they are ancient prayers that shape our longing and reorient our priorities.

Yes, we will put up lights, shop for gifts, plan family gatherings, and decorate our homes. These outward preparations have their place and can even become prayer when offered with love. But the Church, in her wisdom, gives us something deeper: the grace to prepare the inner landscape of our souls. This is why the opportunities for sacramental reconciliation during Advent are such precious gifts. At both St. Matthew and St. Hubert churches, confession opportunities have been scheduled for the Advent season. Please check the bulletin and the parish website for the complete schedule. There is no better way to “make straight the paths” than to receive God’s mercy in this beautiful sacrament.

Our parish staff and countless volunteers have worked tirelessly to offer events and activities that help parishioners of every age prepare for Christmas in a truly meaningful way. From various service projects to Advent reflections, theological seminars, Bible studies and much more there is something for everyone. The Giving Tree stands ready in the gathering space, waiting for tags that will bring joy to families in need. The Simbang Gabi, adorations, prepare your hearts retreat, Men4Jesus, Bible Study, the Chosen Series, Cookies Cocoa and Christ, young adult events, Christmas concert and many more moments are

designed to keep our eyes fixed on the true meaning of Christmas: God-with-us, Emmanuel, the Light who scatters every darkness.

I must pause here and share something personal. A month ago I traveled home to Kerala, India, to celebrate the silver jubilee of my priestly ordination with my family and the parish where I was raised. Twenty-five years! It feels surreal. I stood at the same altar where I celebrated my first Mass and wondered, “Where did the time go?” Five years as a missionary priest in the villages of North India, twenty years serving the people of God in the Archdiocese of Chicago—memories flooded back of baptisms, weddings, hospital rooms at 1 AM., and countless confessions where I witnessed the triumph of grace over sin. Through it all, one truth has remained constant: I am unspeakably privileged to be a priest of Jesus Christ.

And now, by God’s generous providence, I have been blessed to walk with all of you at Holy Archangels Parish. Your love, your care, your faithfulness—not only toward me but toward one another and toward this parish family—humbles me every single day. You make the priesthood a joy. Together we are preparing not just for one Christmas, but for the eternal Christmas when we will see the Lord face to face.

So let us not allow these fleeting Advent days to slip away unnoticed. Light the candles. Sing Christmas hymns. Come to confession. Join the parish events. Open your hearts wide. The One who came once in humility is coming again in glory, and He desires to find us ready—watching, waiting, and burning with love.





## PRAYER CORNER

Prayer of the Week

### The Holy Rosary: Luminous Mysteries

The Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary, also known as the Mysteries of Light, were introduced by Pope St. John Paul II in 2002 to help deepen reflection on the public life of Jesus. These five mysteries are traditionally prayed on Thursdays, and they focus on key moments in Jesus' ministry that reveal His identity as the Light of the World. Each mystery invites us to grow in understanding of Christ's mission and to live out His teachings more fully. Alongside each mystery is a spiritual fruit, a grace we ask God to cultivate in our hearts as we pray. Here is a summary of each Luminous Mystery and its spiritual fruit:

#	Luminous Mystery	Verse	Spiritual Fruit
1	The Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan	Matthew 3:16-17	Openness to the Holy Spirit
2	The Wedding at Cana	John 2:5-11	To Jesus through Mary
3	The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God	Mark 1:15	Repentance and Trust in God
4	The Transfiguration	Matthew 17:2	Desire for Holiness
5	The Institution of the Eucharist	Luke 22:19-20	Eucharistic Adoration

The Luminous Mysteries invite us to reflect on the light of Christ shining through His teachings, miracles, and sacraments. They highlight moments when Jesus revealed the Father's love and called people to live in truth and grace. These mysteries help us grow in spiritual understanding and encourage us to follow Christ more closely in our daily lives. By praying the Luminous Mysteries, we are reminded that we are called to be bearers of His light—bringing hope, healing, and truth to the world around us.



## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

This week we hear that John the Baptist is out in the wilderness eating "locusts and wild honey" (Mark 1:6). It's not just a strange historical detail. It's a symbolic expression of a healthy spiritual diet. The path to Christ includes both the hard and the beautiful, the gritty and the sweet. We have to learn to gulp the locusts and savor the honey.

I remember working with a young couple preparing for marriage. They were sincere, but raw — barely beginning to discover faith. Part of me wanted to rush them ahead, to fill in all the gaps, to bombard them with scripture and church documents. I swallowed that instinct. It was like eating locusts.

But I also recall them light up as they spoke about each other, about their first child, then their second. And they wanted to be close to God. Something innocent and beautiful was unfolding. That was the honey. I knew God was asking me to savor it.

This Advent, maybe we're each being invited to accept both locusts and honey. Maybe it's time to stop avoiding the difficult parts of faith — prayer that feels dry, the call to repentance, the patience with the troublesome. It's time to eat some locusts.

But we also need to notice the small gifts God gives us: a peaceful moment, a good conversation, the joy of serving someone else, new life, good intentions of our friends. That's the honey. Savor it!

John didn't avoid either. He took it all in. And so can we. What are your locusts? Your honey? If we let God feed us with both, we'll be ready — really ready — for the coming of Christ.
