

As we gather in this sacred season of Christmas, our hearts turn with special joy to the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. This beautiful feast reminds us that God Himself chose to enter the world not as a solitary figure, but through the intimate bonds of a family. Jesus, the Son of God, humbled Himself to be

born into a human home in Nazareth, where He lived under the care of Mary, His loving Mother, and Joseph, His faithful guardian and provider.

In the quiet village of Nazareth, we see the perfect form of family as revealed in Sacred Scripture: a father, a mother, and Son living together in harmony, rooted in faith. Joseph protected and provided, Mary nurtured with tenderness, and Jesus grew in wisdom, submitting in obedience to His parents (Luke 2:51). This simple household became the cradle of salvation, showing us that the family—father, mother, and children—is God's design for human flourishing. It is the foundation of society, and upon strong families, civilizations are built and sustained.

Today, however, families face enormous challenges: pressures from a fast-paced world, divisions caused by technology, economic strains, cultural shifts, ideologies that undermine marriage and parenthood, and spiritual attacks that seek to erode faith in the home. Yet, God continues to bless every family rooted in prayer, where Jesus is invited as the honored guest. When we welcome Christ into our homes—through daily prayer, Scripture reading, and the sacraments—He transforms ordinary moments into occasions of grace. Let us pray earnestly for all families, especially those struggling, that they may find strength in the example of Nazareth.

It was a delight to see so many of you joining us for our Christmas celebrations this year—families young and old, visitors and longtime parishioners filling our church with joy and song. Your presence reminds us that we, too, are

part of a larger family: the family of God here at our parish. God bless each one of you abundantly in this season of hope.

St. Hubert Parking lot update: On a practical note, I want to share an encouraging update on our parking lot project. Thanks be to God and to your fervent prayers! We have received the engineering report from the Archdiocese, and the great news is that we do not need to fully reconstruct the parking lot at St. Hubert as initially feared. This saves us a tremendous amount of money and resources.

Our current goal is to raise \$147,774.00 by May 30, 2026, toward the estimated cost of over \$460,000 to repave the entire lot. We have secured four bids, set aside \$245,338, proceeds from the sale of the St. Hubert rectory, and already raised over \$74,000 through your generosity. This parking lot is more than asphalt—it is part of our spiritual home. It welcomes young families with children, elderly parishioners, couples celebrating weddings, mourners at funerals, and countless visitors for Masses, events, and sacraments.

I kindly ask you to continue supporting this effort and help raise \$147,774.00 by May 30th, 2026. Please use the special envelopes available in the Narthex or write a check designated for the parking lot project. Every contribution, large or small, helps us maintain a safe and inviting space for all who come to encounter Christ here.

As we honor the Holy Family today, let us renew our commitment to make our own families and our parish family places where Jesus dwells. May Jesus, Mary and Joseph intercede for us, blessing our homes with peace, our parish with unity, and our efforts with success.





As we return home from our recent pilgrimage to Italy, I find myself deeply grateful—not only for the holy places we visited, but for the 33 wonderful people with whom I was privileged to journey. Pilgrimage changes us. It slows us down, opens our eyes, and reminds us that faith is something we walk into together, step by step.

Providentially, our pilgrimage unfolded during the season of Advent—a time when the Church invites us to watch, to wait, and to prepare our hearts for the coming of the Lord. Advent is itself a pilgrimage of hope. As the prophet Isaiah reminds us, *“Let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, that He may instruct us in His ways, and we may walk in His paths”* (Isaiah 2:3). In many ways, this verse became the quiet refrain of our journey.

From our arrival in Rome and onward through Florence, Siena, Assisi, Gubbio, and back again to the Eternal City, each step reminded us that faith is not abstract but is lived, embodied, and handed down. In the great basilicas of Rome, we were repeatedly drawn back to the mystery of Christ truly present among us. Celebrating Mass at Santa Maria Maggiore and praying before the relics of the Holy Crib reminded us that the Word who became flesh continues to dwell with His people—most profoundly in the Eucharist. As pilgrims, we were reminded that the same Lord we adored in ancient churches is the Lord who meets us every Sunday at Holy Archangels Parish altars.

Walking through the streets of Rome, the Catacombs, and the Colosseum, we encountered the witness of the early Christians—men and women who lived their faith with courage and trust, often at great cost. Their lives echo the words of St. Paul, whose tomb we visited: *“I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith”* (2 Timothy 4:7). Their witness invites us to ask how we, in our own time and place, are called to live that same faith with integrity and hope.

Our time in Assisi was especially moving. At the tomb of St. Francis and in the quiet of the *Eremo delle Carceri*, we were gently reminded that holiness is not found in grandeur alone, but in simplicity, humility, and joyful trust in God. St. Francis teaches us that the Christian life is not about possessing much, but about allowing Christ to possess us fully.

Even moments of disappointment—such as the cancellation of the Papal Audience—became moments of grace. Pilgrimage, like life, rarely unfolds exactly as planned. Yet Advent assures us that God comes precisely into the unexpected, the unfinished, and the unprepared. *“Be watchful! Be alert! You do not know when the time will come”* (Mark 13:33).

As we now continue our Advent journey at home, my prayer is that the fruits of this pilgrimage will remain alive among us: a deeper love for the Eucharist, renewed commitment to prayer, gratitude for the communion of saints, and a strengthened desire to welcome Christ more fully into our lives.

We return not simply as travelers who have seen holy places, but as pilgrims whose hearts have been renewed. May we continue to walk together in faith, awaiting the Lord who comes—again and again—into our world and into our lives.

May the fruits of this pilgrimage continue to unfold in our parish and families, and may we remember that we are always pilgrims, journeying together toward the Kingdom of God.



Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

When I was ten, my dad gathered our family around the table in small-town Vermont and told us we were moving to the big desert city of Phoenix, Arizona. We were leaving behind family, friends, and everything familiar. None of us knew what to expect.

But something beautiful happened. As we made the move together, our family grew closer. In retrospect, I'm amazed at my parents' courage to go on that adventure. Even as a kid I realized our family found, in that challenge, a deeper unity and mutual love.

In today's Gospel, Joseph is told: **"Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee..." (Matthew 2:13, 20).** First to Egypt, then later to Israel. The Holy Family is frequently challenged to move and change, to adapt to God's will for them, in order to find safety in the midst of threat. It's not just an idiosyncratic story about survival. It's a spiritual pattern for all of us. Every Christian family is called to be a kind of sanctuary, especially in a world full of noise, busyness, and fear.

May I make a practical application for us? The Lord's Day, Sunday, is perhaps the most practical way we imitate this dynamic we see in Joseph and his family. Sunday is not meant to be just like every other day, filled with errands and stress. It's meant to be a day set apart; a holy "escape" into rest, worship, joy, and peace. A day to rise, take your family, and flee, into God's presence.






THEOLOGICAL SEMINAR WITH FR. KARTJE
