

Dear Parishioners of Holy Archangels Parish,

I would like to share an important update regarding the present situation of St. Hubert School in Hoffman Estates. I offer this message in a spirit of honesty, transparency, and shared discernment as we continue seeking God's will for both our parish and our school.

For more than sixty years, St. Hubert School has been a central ministry of St. Hubert Parish and now within Holy Archangels Parish following the merger. Across generations, countless students have been formed in its classrooms, grounded in Catholic faith, values, and service. This enduring legacy reflects the commitment and sacrifices of teachers, staff, parents, parishioners, and benefactors over many decades.

At the same time, St. Hubert School, like many Catholic schools today, has faced serious and ongoing challenges. The most significant has been declining enrollment, which has placed increasing strain on finances. These struggles did not arise suddenly but developed over time due to shifting demographics, economic pressures, and changing cultural priorities. Hoffman Estates and Schaumburg are diverse communities, many families may not fully understand or prioritize the distinctive value of Catholic education—one that integrates faith, character formation, service, and academic excellence. For other families, the cost of tuition remains a real hardship, despite our best efforts to keep it affordable.

Even in the midst of these difficulties, the support shown to St. Hubert School during the last 10 years and more has been remarkable. The Archdiocese of Chicago demonstrated extraordinary generosity by forgiving more than \$673,417 in school operating debt for the fiscal years 2023 and 2024, along with over \$2 million in parish debt. This act of mercy allowed both the parish and school to continue their mission with renewed hope. Our parish community has also shown steadfast support over the years through tuition assistance contributions, direct financial help to meet payroll needs, and strong participation in school fundraising initiatives.

Shortly after my arrival at Holy Archangels in April 2024, the Archdiocesan Office of Catholic Schools convened a "State of the School" meeting. The message was clear: for St. Hubert School to remain viable, enrollment needed to grow and fundraising efforts needed to be significantly strengthened. In response, the school board developed a three-year strategic plan, submitted in March 2025, with goals of reaching 240 students and raising \$302,000 annually.

There were encouraging signs of progress. Enrollment increased to nearly 219 students last year, and the fundraising committee raised more than \$281,319 through events, donations, and grants. At the same time, the

Catholic Identity Team, made important strides in strengthening the relationship between the school and the parish by encouraging greater participation in parish life.

However, as we stand at the beginning of January 2026, we face renewed and serious challenges. Enrollment has declined to 161 students due to many reasons including staffing adjustments, program reductions, and the loss of the Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship (TCS) program, the school's financial situation has become increasingly difficult. The projected operating deficit now exceeds \$347,004. The school board has been given a fundraising goal of \$168,990; if this goal is not met, the deficit will rise to approximately \$515,994 this fiscal year. Because of this reality, I write to you with both honesty and hope.

In mid-January, Cardinal Blase J. Cupich, along with the Vicars and the Office of Catholic Schools, will evaluate several schools across the Archdiocese, including St. Hubert, and make decisions regarding their future.

Our parish also faces financial constraints. While we are grateful for recent debt relief, we anticipate necessary facility improvement projects totaling more than \$2.9 million over the next two to four years. At this time, the parish does not have the capacity to provide additional financial support to the school beyond what is already being offered.

How can you help:

Many of you have supported "Fr. Mike's Kids Campaign," motivated by your love for St. Hubert School. I encourage you to continue supporting this effort if you are able, to share information with alumni and community members, and to reach out to the school if you can offer time, talent, or resources.

In moments of uncertainty, we cling to God's promise: "For I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord... plans to give you hope and a future" (Jeremiah 29:11). I ask you to join me in prayer for our students, families, teachers, and staff, and for the wisdom to trust in God's plan. United in faith and prayer, may we move forward with courage, compassion, and hope.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Apple ran a commercial not long ago called "Behind the Mac - Greatness." It shows artists and creators, such as Kendrick Lamar, Billie Eilish, and Lady Gaga, working behind their MacBooks. The narration says, "There's a certain kind of person who doesn't wait for greatness. They make it." It's a compelling message. There's beauty in using our gifts with passion and purpose. But there lies a hidden weight in that idea: If you are what you make, what happens when you can't anymore? When the project fails, the passion fades, or the spotlight moves on, where is greatness then?



Today's Gospel offers a differing vision of greatness. Jesus steps into the Jordan River. He hasn't preached, healed, or performed a single miracle. Then the heavens open, and the Father speaks: **"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."** It's not a reward for success. It's not earned. Before he does anything "great," Jesus receives the greatness of his identity from the Father.

And so do you. At your baptism, God said the same thing over you: "You are my beloved." That is your true identity, not constructed or earned but received. When we see ourselves and others this way, everything changes for the better. We discover a greatness that can never be taken away.

This week, reflect on your baptism: look up the date, thank God for it, pray for those baptized with you, or visit the church where it happened. Let your identity be rooted there.


