### Path to the Pantry November 2023

The support to the North County Food Pantry from our local community and beyond has been so encouraging. The Colville Elks recently donated \$2000 to provide food, household items and clothing to neighbors affected by the Oregon Road Fire. In addition, Catholic Charities Rice Bowl Project awarded a significant grant to support our community garden, which each year yields thousands of pounds of fresh produce for our clients. Our shelves are currently well stocked, and we are collecting warm winter clothing and bedding to distribute to clients in need. Storage space is limited so we ask that donated clothing are seasonally appropriate.

At least one local business is initiating a food drive over the holidays with our Pantry as the beneficiary. We welcome this kind of support and encourage others to do the same. In addition to non-perishable food items, families can always use toiletries, toilet paper, feminine hygiene products, and shaving supplies. Food items like bags of flour and sugar, cake mixes and canned proteins are most appreciated.

Volunteers are the key to the Pantry's success and we are grateful to Jack, who has volunteered to pick up "grocery rescue" from grocers. Also thanks to Glenna who is housekeeping and cleaning. If you can help, please call Sandy at (509) 292-2530.

No more than two dinners can be loaded into a vehicle. You do not need to be a client of the Food Pantry to participate, but do need to sign up in advance at the Pantry. Hours are Monday 10-2 and Wednesday 8:30-noon. Please arrive 15 minutes before closing time.
