

Dear Friends,

I am excited to welcome Marlene Stammerman to our Pastoral team. Marlene began her work for our parish as our Director of Discipleship this past Monday. Next weekend, she will have an opportunity to introduce herself to the parish at all the Masses.

With her coming on board we have begun to rework our job descriptions and titles. I'd like to share a little bit about that now but more information will be coming in the next few weeks. All of these changes are being done to align us more closely with the Divine Renovation Network. I firmly believe that this network will help us achieve our mission of making and growing disciples.

As Director of Discipleship Marlene will have a couple of main tasks. She will be our lead minister for Youth and Young Adult Ministries. In addition to that she will work closely with Jesse and the Spiritual Life Committee planning spiritual growth opportunities for our parish (missions and retreats). Marlene will also be tasked with Adult Faith Formation programming; marriage enrichment programs and she will oversee all Bible Studies. Finally, Marlene has a degree in counseling and a certificate in spiritual direction and hopes to make herself available on a limited basis in each of those areas.

As Marlene comes on board there will also be a little shift in Kristina's job. She will now be called our Director of Evangelization. She will continue to oversee our Religious Education Program (including Vacation Bible School) for our young church as well as RCIA. She will be adding our new Alpha program which we hope will become the cornerstone of our commitment to evangelization. Kristina will oversee our confirmation program as well as our connect groups (a follow up to Alpha) that will start sometime next year.

Much more information about these changes will be coming in the next few weeks. Again all of this is being done to serve the mission of our parish of making and growing disciples.


