There are answers to many questions about the project which are included in the details that follow. The information also details how each of us can make a sacrificial gift using our Suggested Gift Chart.

The Suggested Gift Chart shows a wide range of pledges payable over three years. This wide range of gift opportunities makes it possible for virtually every family to take part in the program. Please give prayerful consideration to your pledge during the next few days and join with me in praying for the success of our campaign.

The Scope of the Project

Leaks in the roof, ice dams, ripped carpets, broken down heating and A/C systems, rooms needing a paint job! Sound familiar? We all love our homes but we also realize that they are in constant need of repair and updating both or safety and our enjoyment. Our parish home is no different. The chart, based on the in-depth study by Spadling De Decker Engineering and Roofing Technology Associates brings awareness to needed repairs and proactive adjustments. Our plan is to begin these changes next year and continue in subsequent years, allowing us to provide a safe, welcoming environment where we can gather, worship, and call our spiritual home.

The costs indicated are the best estimates to cover our needs.

PARKING LOT

This spring, we addressed the most serious problems in our parking lot and repaved the north portion of the parking lot. This required improving drainage and the subsurface and cost \$143,350, which we were able to pay for from savings we obtained from your generous giving.

The remaining southern portion of the lot still needs to be repaived. We have obtained bids for the work required as outlined by our civil engineering firm, Spalding de Decker. This work needs to be completed as soon as the funds are available.

COST: \$608,000

CHURCH ROOFS

We engaged Roofing Technology Associates, Ltd., to do an assessment and replacement cost estimate on the roofs of the parish buildings. With proper maintenance, they may still perform well for a few more years, depending on the section studied. The roof over the man church needs to be replaced in the next 2-4 years at an estimated replacement cost of \$152,000. The roof over the social hall is expected to last 4-8 more years before needing replacement at an estimated roof over the social hall is expected to last 4-8 more years before needing replacement at an estimated cost of \$410,000.

COST: \$542,000

PIANO

The piano in the church was is a lovely instrument, and was given to the parish in memory of our former pastor. Fr. Ed Schlwager by his family when he died. It has served us well for close to 30 years, but is no longer able to hold tune well and is in need of replacement.

COST: \$60,000

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. When will the work begin?
The work will begin as the funds become available from the Capital Campaign. We plan to do the south parking lot first, the church roof second and the social hall roof third. A piano will be bought as soon as a suitable

Q. What will happen if we go over our goal?
All gifts collected after we exceed our goal will be put
towards the maintenance and upkeep of our facilities in
our Major Repairs savings account. This is the account
we used to finance the \$143,350 parking lot repair this spring.

 What if I never make a pledge?

Most people take advantage of time-payments for majo purchases. A pledge to the parish Capital Campaign is a "time-payment plan" that makes it possible for you to meet your parish obligations without undue hardship. Pledges enable you to consider a more significant contribution to the campaign rather than a one-time gift.

Q. Is my pledge over and above my Sunday Offering? Yes. We can only reach our goal with a little extra sacrifice. We cannot reach our goal if we reduce our weekly offerings in order to make a pledge to the Capital Campaign. The parish will continue to have normal operating expenses during the pledge period.

Q. Who will be asked to support the Campaign? Q. Who will be asked to support the Campaign?

Each member of our parish family will be asked to consider a significant gift for this major effort according to his or her financial shallby. We will make a special appeal to all who have been blessed by the Lord with exceptional earning ability or have been able to accumulate some assets. We hope everyone will play a conscientious role in renewing the future of the parish.

Q. What happens if I cannot fulfill my pledge?
Pledges are made in good faith and accepted as such. If hardship or illness prevents you from fulfilling your pledge, let the parish know, and other arrangements will be made.

Suggested Gift Plans

We can reach our goal together if every family will set aside, over the next 36 months, at least \$3.13 a day or \$94 a month. If, however, you are not able to do this, your pledge in any amount is encouraged and will be gratefully received.

We are asking that you consider how generous God has been to you and that you respond in proportion to your own financial ability. As you consider your Christian stewardship, we ask you to prayerfully consider a sacrificial gift of a few dollars a day or week which will amount to a significant gift for the growth of our parish.

The Suggested Gift Plan encourages financial commitments over a three year period. The pledge card provides space for you to designate payment intervals: monthly, quarterly, semi-annually, or annually. Payment reminders will be sent in accordance with the schedule selected. We ask you to keep in mind that it will take gifts at these levels over 36 months to reach our goal. Pledges enable you to consider a more significant contribution to the campaign rather than a one-time gift.
