Saint of the Week

Because we live so close to Villanova University and we welcome Fr. Lee to our parish each week, we have chosen for our saint of the week – St. Nicholas of Tolentine, the first canonized Augustinian.

Nicholas was born to a poor family in 1245 in Pontano, Italy. His parents had prayed for a child at the shrine of St. Nicholas of Myra. When he was 18 he became an Augustinian monk and served the church by preaching in whatever town he was sent. Eventually he was missioned to Tolentino, a city in political turmoil. Nicholas, however, spent his days serving the poor, sick, and celebrating sacraments. It is said that one night he had a dream in which a friar spoke to him from purgatory and asked him to have Masses prayed for the souls there. Nicholas did as he was asked. A few weeks later that same friar appeared in Nicholas' dream and said that through his prayer many souls had entered heaven. Nicholas is considered the patron saint of the souls in purgatory.

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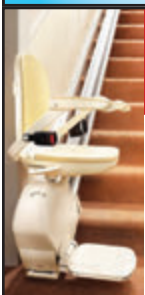
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
