Gospels of Mark 8:22 – 10:52 September 16th thru October 28th

Beginning with last Sunday's Gospel and continuing through Sunday October 28th, our Gospel reading is from a section of Mark's Gospel where Jesus is dealing with the blindness of sighted people. Although Jesus has been teaching and preaching, and performing miracles, there are sighted people who can neither see nor understand who Jesus is and what his mission is. In these passages (Mark 8: 22 – 10:52),

Jesus is teaching his disciples and trying to give them insight into what it means to be a disciple, to be his follower.

Mark begins and ends this section of his Gospel with Jesus healing a blind man. At this point in the Gospel, Jesus is headed for Jerusalem where crucifixion awaits him. On the way to Jerusalem, Mark sees Jesus giving intense instructions to his disciples so, like the blind man, they could begin to see who Jesus is.

Mark 8:22 notes that Jesus had to touch the eyes of this blind man a second time because after the first touch, he did not have 20/20 vision because to him the people he saw looked like dancing trees. This initial blurred vision of the man symbolizes how the disciples, we, and people who are spiritually blind need Jesus to touch us again and again to grace us with a spiritual vision and insight that is 20/20.

Although Peter in last Sunday's Gospel identified Jesus as the Messiah, Peter misunderstood what Messiah. Jesus attempts to help Peter see that the Messiah will suffer, be rejected, put to death, and then rise three days later.

In today's Gospel, Jesus attempts to help the disciples see that true greatness is to be found in service.

I suggest that you read this entire section in Mark's Gospel to help you see and appreciate what Jesus is trying to do. As we proclaim a passage from this section over the next six Sundays, we will have an opportunity to check and examine our vision to see if we look at life and certain issues as Jesus does. May Jesus who healed not only people who were physically blind and the spiritual blindness of his disciples, help you and me to see more clearly the life we are called to live as Christ's disciples.

HUMANAE VITAE AT 50

Humanae Vitae noted the moral and cultural perils of contraception, and their contradiction of God's will for each husband and wife to perfect one another and cooperate in the generation and rearing of new life.

In the fifty years since the promulgation of *Humanae Vitae*, the Church's teaching has been challenged, rejected, and even ridiculed by the secular culture. But, as Archbishop Charles Chaput recently noted, "*Humanae Vitae* remains a powerful counter-witness to the widespread sexual dysfunction of our age as other Christian communities, and even, many Catholics, have collapsed in their defense of sexual integrity. *Humanae Vitae* has remained a testimony to the truth."

Consider: The pill separates the divinely ordained and self-evident "dual purpose" of the conjugal act: new life and marital unity.

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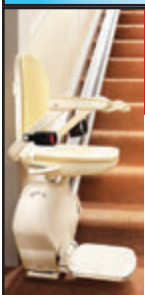
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
