The Lord will choose whomever he wishes to proclaim the Good News

The precepts of the Lord prive joy to the heart.

Our Gospel from Mark chapter nine gives two sobering insights: first, any person who loves God and acts uprightly, the Lord may well use to proclaim his Gospel and bring healing to the people. "Lord, there is someone who is curing in your name, but he is not of our number (of the 12 disciples). Jesus responds, leave him alone. In order to be used as God's instrument you need to have professed your love of God. Why the Lord chooses one blessed person over another blessed person to exercise a ministry remains a mystery. But he does.

There is a second powerful insight: sin is dangerous and how dangerous is it? If my eye is my difficulty pluck it out. If my hand is my difficulty cut it off. These metaphors ought to scare us. We need to know that walking thru life without repentance and reform is dangerous. Seek the mercy of God, repent. Accept the second grace that builds up the strength in me in order for me to reform my life.

Now please return to Psalm 19, our response for today: The precepts of the Lord give joy to the heart. It is a beautiful reflection on the Glory of God in creation and the blessing of wisdom that comes when life is lived according to God's plan and not my near sighted plan. His wisdom guides and lights our paths in everything. Psalm 19 reflects a grateful heart because, if I am WILLING, his grace will keep a guard over the intentions of my heart, the words of mouth and all my actions.
