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Violence is the Enemy of Hope.

In recent years, and surely in these last weeks we have been witnesses to more violence.
Useless bloodshed.

The prophet Habakkuk was witness to a similar slaughter. So he takes on this problem as dear to his own heart, striving to make some sense of it all. Habakkuk is writing around the year 605 B.C. He challenges God to intervene and God is for a time silent. He mourns his silent God, yet does not give up his prayer of hope. The prophet is promised that justice will be served, but first the Lord will give fair warning:

1. Woe to him who stores up what is not his: how long can it last?
2. Woe to him who pursues evil gain for his household, setting his nest on high, you have devised shame for your household.
3. Woe to you who builds a city by bloodshed and establishes a town by wickedness.
4. Woe to you who give your neighbors a flood of your wrath to drink; you are filled with shame instead of God's glory.

Surely, this is most grim. But the eternal optimist, Habakkuk takes hold of the Promise once again and Proclaims a path of righteousness: "Yet will I rejoice in the Lord and exult in my saving God. God, my Lord, is my strength". The prophet would be well familiar with the Psalms and surely Psalm 23: Though I walk in the dark valley, I fear no evil.

The essential question for us today is:
How can I today be an instrument of Peace?

Three suggestions:

1. I will think before I speak.
2. Pray for self-control.
3. Work for justice and reject retaliation.

Step 3: When you click, "Continue to payment," you will be prompted to add a credit card or set up an electronic fund transfer, or login to your existing account. Follow the steps to set up a new account.

Step 4: Finalize the set-up and you are ready to go.

Step 5: If you still desire to use paper envelopes please, mark on your envelope that you have given electronically and bring them to Church. Sometimes, especially for children, it is good to have something tangible to put in the collection basket.

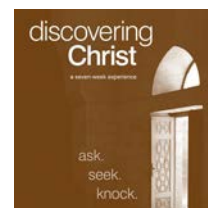
