Choose one of the prompts below for your <u>Required</u> summer reading assignment for <u>The Magicians Nephew</u>. Submit either assignment #1 or #2.

- 1. Book Review: This is a two paragraph (minimum 5 lines for each paragraph) review. The first paragraph should be a short summary of the entire book including the plot, setting, main characters, point of view, theme, and resolution (must include all). The second paragraph should be a personal evaluation of the book including how the book made you feel, would you recommend the book to a friend, and why or why not (Must include all). For fifth grade, this assignment must be hand-written in cursive.
- 2. Movie Poster: Use a Tri-Fold presentation board. Create a cast for each main character in the book (section one), rate the movie out of five stars and tell why you chose that rating (section two), and <u>illustrate</u> a picture or scene from the novel that encompasses the essence of the book (section three).
