

1st Grade Summer One-Pager Assignment – Religion Class

Topic: *The Ten Commandments & The Two Greatest Commandments – God’s Rules of Love*

Due : **MONDAY AUGUST 18, 2025**

Total Points: 100

I. Why This Assignment?

In 1st grade, you’ll grow in learning how to love God and love others. One of the ways we do that is by following God’s rules, called the **Ten Commandments**. Jesus also gave us the **Two Greatest Commandments** to help us understand that **love** is the most important command. This summer, you’ll make a one-pager that helps you learn, draw, and **memorize** these commandments so you’re ready to live like Jesus every day.

II. Instructions for Students (with help from parents):

Create a **one-page visual project** showing the **10 Commandments**, the **2 Greatest Commandments**, and your faith reflections using drawings, short sentences, and color.

III. Your One-Pager Must Include:

1. **Creative Title (5 points):** Examples: *“God’s Rules of Love”*, *“10 + 2 Commandments”*, *“Love God. Love Others.”*

2. **The Ten Commandments (20 points)**
 1. *I am the Lord your God; you shall not have strange gods before Me.*
 2. *You shall not take the Name of the Lord your God in vain.*
 3. *Remember to keep holy the Lord's day.*
 4. *Honor your father and your mother.*
 5. *You shall not kill.*
 6. *You shall not commit adultery.*
 7. *You shall not steal.*
 8. *You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour.*
 9. *You shall not covet your neighbour's wife.*
 10. *You shall not covet your neighbour's goods.*

2. **The Two Greatest Commandments (10 points):** Write these in big, colorful letters:
 1. *Love the Lord your God with all your heart, mind, soul, and strength*
 2. *Love your neighbor as yourself.*
(Matthew 22:37–39)

3. **Drawings or Symbols (20 points):** Draw pictures for at least **2 of the Ten Commandments** and each of the **Two Greatest Commandments**.

4. Explain 2 Commandments (10 points)

Pick two commandments and write one sentence about what they mean to you.

Example: *“I follow #4 when I help my mom clean up.”*

5. Faith Reflection (10 points): Write or draw:

- “How do the commandments help me love God and others?”
- “Which commandment is easy or hard for me?”

6. Memorization Practice (20 points): This summer, **memorize** the following:

- All 10 Commandments
- The Two Greatest Commandments
