3rd Grade Summer One-Pager Assignment - Religion Class

Topic: The Great Commandment & The Works of Mercy – Loving God and Helping Others

Due: Monday, August 18, 2025

Total Points: 100

I. Why This Assignment?

In 3rd grade, you'll learn how Jesus teaches us to **love God and love others**. We live out that love by following the **Great Commandment** and practicing the **Works of Mercy**—ways we care for people's bodies (corporal) and hearts (spiritual). This assignment will help you begin living your faith through action and love.

II. Instructions for Students:

Create a **one-page project** on paper or poster that includes drawings and writing to show what you've learned about the **Great Commandment**, the **Corporal Works of Mercy**, and the **Spiritual Works of Mercy**.

III. Your One-Pager Must Include:

1. Title (5 points) Examples: "Love Like Jesus", "The Works of Mercy", "Faith in Action"

2. The Great Commandment (10 points) Write both parts of the Great Commandment:

- 1. Love the Lord your God with all your heart.
- 2. Love your neighbor as yourself.
- 3. Memorize this commandment for class discussion.

4. The 7 Corporal Works of Mercy (10 points) Write and decorate this list:

- 1. Feed the hungry
- 2. Give drink to the thirsty
- 3. Clothe the naked
- 4. Shelter the homeless
- 5. Visit the sick
- 6. Visit the imprisoned
- 7. Bury the dead

5. The 7 Spiritual Works of Mercy (10 points) Write and decorate this list:

- 1. Instruct the ignorant
- 2. Counsel the doubtful
- 3. Comfort the sorrowful
- 4. Bear wrongs patiently
- 5. Forgive offenses willingly
- 6. Admonish the sinner
- 7. Pray for the living and the dead

6. Choose & Explain (10 points) Pick 1 corporal and 1 spiritual work of mercy and write one sentence each explaining how you can live them out.

Example: "I can comfort the sorrowful by sitting with a sad friend."

- 7. **Drawings (10 points):** Draw **at least 3 pictures** showing someone doing a work of mercy or living the Great Commandment.
- **8. Reflection (5 points):** Answer this in 1–2 sentences:
- "How do the Works of Mercy help us follow Jesus?"
- 9. Memorization Practice (30 points) This summer, memorize:
 - 1. The **Great Commandment** (2 parts)
 - 2. The 7 Corporal Works of Mercy
 - 3. The 7 Spiritual Works of Mercy
 - Practice by saying them out loud, using flashcards, or writing them from memory.
