# 4th Grade Summer One-Pager Assignment – Religion Class

Topic: The Beatitudes – Jesus' Way to True Happiness

**Due: MONDAY AUGUST 18, 2025** 

**Total Points: 100** 

#### I. Why This Assignment?

In 4th grade, you'll grow in your understanding of **how to live as a follower of Jesus**. One of the most important teachings Jesus gave us is the **Beatitudes**—eight beautiful promises found in the **Sermon on the Mount** (Matthew 5:1–12). They teach us how to love, trust, and live as children of God.

This summer, you'll explore the **meaning of the Beatitudes**, create a one-pager to help remember them, and begin **memorizing their names**. This will help you prepare to live like Jesus and recognize what true happiness really means.

#### **II.** Instructions for Students:

Create a **one-page visual and written project** that explains the **8 Beatitudes** in a way that makes sense to you. Add symbols, colors, and reflections to make it creative and meaningful.

#### **III.** Your One-Pager Must Include:

- 1. **Title (5 points):** Choose a creative title for your one-pager (e.g., "The Way of Jesus", "Happy Are They", or "The Beatitudes: God's Blessings" or Ways to Heaven").
- **2. The Eight Beatitudes (10 points):** Write out the **8 Beatitudes** (from Matthew 5:1–12). You can use a children's Bible or the simplified version provided here:
- **3.** What Each One Means (30 points): For each Beatitude, write 1 short sentence in your own words explaining what it means.

Example: "Blessed are the merciful" means I should forgive others and be kind to those who make mistakes.

- 4. **Symbols or Drawings (10 points):** Add a **symbol or drawing** to match each Beatitude (e.g., a heart for "pure of heart," a dove for "peacemakers," etc.).
- 5. Key Phrase Highlight (5 points)

Choose your favorite Beatitude and write it in big letters or decorate it in a special way on the page.

- **6.** Faith Reflection (20 points): Write a short reflection (3–5 sentences):
  - Which Beatitude is hardest for you?
  - Which one do you already try to live?
  - Why do you think Jesus gave us the Beatitudes?
- 7. Memorization Practice (10 points): Memorize the names of all 8 Beatitudes
  - Practice saying them out loud with family
  - You will be quizzed at the beginning of the school year!
- **8.** Neatness, Creativity & Effort (10 points): Use your best handwriting, add color, organize your space well, and show effort in your drawings and writing.
