5th Grade Summer One-Pager Assignment – Religion Class

**Topic:** *The Seven Sacraments – Signs of God's Grace* 

Due: MONDAY AUGUST 18, 2025

**Total Points: 100** 

I. Why This Assignment?

In 5th grade, your Religion class will focus on the **Sacraments**—the special signs of God's grace that help us grow in holiness and live as members of the Church. The **Seven Sacraments** are at the heart of our Catholic faith and connect us to Jesus in every stage of life.

This summer, you'll create a **one-pager** to show what you know about the **Seven Sacraments** and begin **memorizing their names**. This will help you get ready to dive deeper into each one during the school year!

**II.** Instructions for Students:

Create a **one-page visual and written summary** of the **Seven Sacraments**. Your one-pager will include short explanations, drawings, and a commitment to memorize all 7 by heart.

**III.** Your One-Pager Must Include:

1. Title (5 points): Create a creative title such as "Signs of Grace", "The Seven Sacraments", or "Jesus Gives Us Grace".

2. Names of the Seven Sacraments (10 points): List all 7 Sacraments clearly on your page. They must be spelled correctly and grouped under their 3 categories:

1. Sacraments of Initiation

- Baptism
- Eucharist
- Confirmation

2. Sacraments of Healing

- Reconciliation (Penance or Confession)
- Anointing of the Sick

3. Sacraments of Service (Vocation)

Holy Orders

- Matrimony
- 3. **Memorize these 7 Sacraments** over the summer. You will be asked to say or write them from memory at the start of the school year!
- **4. Short Explanation of Each Sacrament (35 points):** Write **1–2 sentences** in your own words to explain each Sacrament. For example:
  - Baptism: In Baptism, we become members of the Church and are freed from original sin.
- **5. Visual Elements (10 points):** Include **symbols or drawings** for each Sacrament (e.g., water for Baptism, chalice for Eucharist, rings for Matrimony, etc.).
- **6. Faith Reflection (20 points):** Write a short reflection (3–5 sentences):
  - Which Sacrament have you already received?
  - Which one are you excited to learn more about?
  - Why do you think the Sacraments are important for Catholics?
- 7. Neatness, Creativity & Effort (10 points): Make your one-pager colorful, neat, and well-organized.

  Do your best!
- **8. Memorization Practice (10 points):** Show your commitment to memorizing the names of the 7 Sacraments:
  - Practice saying them aloud to a parent or sibling.

(You do not need to turn in the memorization practice, but you will be quizzed on the names when school begins.)
