

6th Grade Summer One-Pager Assignment – Religion Class

Topic: *The Life of Jesus – From the Annunciation to the Ascension*

Due: MONDAY AUGUST 18, 2025

Total Points: 100

I. Why This Assignment?

As you begin 6th grade, your Religion studies will focus on **Sacred Scripture**—God's Word in the Bible. Before we explore the Old Testament and God's covenant with His people, it's important to reflect on the center of our Catholic faith: **Jesus Christ**, the Son of God and the fulfillment of God's promises.

By reviewing the life of Jesus—from the **Annunciation** to His **Ascension**—you'll build a stronger foundation for understanding how the whole Bible points to Him. This one-pager will help you connect events from the Gospels with Scripture and prepare your heart and mind for a year of growing in faith and knowledge.

II. Instructions for Students:

Create a **one-page project** that summarizes the **life of Jesus** from the **Annunciation** (when Mary learns she will bear the Son of God) to the **Ascension** (when Jesus returns to Heaven after the Resurrection). Your one-pager should include **both written summaries** and **visual elements**.

III. Your One-Pager Must Include:

1. Title (5 points):

- A creative, centered title for your page (e.g., *"The Life of Jesus"*, *"From Heaven to Heaven"*, *"Christ's Journey on Earth"*).

2. Summary of Key Events (40 points): Choose and summarize 8–10 major events in Jesus' life. Write 1–2 sentences per event in your own words.

Examples of events to include:

- The Annunciation
- The Nativity (Birth of Jesus)
- Presentation in the Temple
- Baptism of Jesus
- Calling of the Apostles
- Miracles and Teachings
- The Last Supper
- Crucifixion

- Resurrection
- Ascension

3. Scripture References (10 points)

Include **at least 3 Bible verses** that connect to the events you describe.

Examples:

- Luke 1:26–38 (Annunciation)
- Luke 2:1–20 (Nativity)
- Matthew 3:13–17 (Baptism of Jesus)
- John 20:1–18 (Resurrection)

4. Symbols or Drawings (15 points)

Add a **small drawing, symbol, or image** for each major event.

These can be hand-drawn or neatly added digitally or with small printed pictures.

5. Faith Reflection (20 points)

Write a **short personal reflection** (3–5 sentences):

- What do you admire most about Jesus' life?
- How can you follow His example in your own life?

6. Creativity, Neatness & Effort (10 points)

Use **color**, organize your page clearly, and put care into your work.

You can use a **timeline**, **collage**, or other **creative layout**.
