#### 7th Grade Summer One-Pager Assignment – Religion Class

**Topic:** *The Nicene Creed – What We Believe as Catholics* 

**Due:** MONDAY AUGUST 18, 2025

**Total Points: 100** 

#### I. Why This Assignment?

In 7th grade, your Religion class will focus on **Jesus Christ, the Sacraments, and the truths of our Catholic faith**. One of the most important prayers of our faith is the **Nicene Creed**—a summary of what Catholics believe, prayed together at Mass.

This summer, you will explore the **meaning** of the Nicene Creed and begin **memorizing** it. Knowing the Creed by heart helps you to pray it with purpose, defend your faith with confidence, and grow closer to God.

#### **II.** Instructions for Students:

Create a **one-page project** to show your understanding of the **Nicene Creed**, and begin memorizing it in preparation for 7th grade.

## **III.** Your One-Pager Must Include:

**1. Title (5 points):** A creative title that reflects the purpose of the Creed (e.g., "I Believe", "The Creed of the Church", or "What Catholics Profess").

## 2. Summary of the Creed (40 points)

Break the Nicene Creed into its **main parts**, and explain each part in your own words (1–2 sentences per section).

#### Include:

- Belief in God the Father
- Belief in Jesus Christ (birth, life, death, resurrection)
- Belief in the Holy Spirit
- Belief in the Church
- Belief in forgiveness, resurrection, and eternal life

- **3. Key Phrases (10 points):** Choose **2–3 important lines** from the Creed and highlight or decorate them on your one-pager. Examples:
  - "God from God, Light from Light..."
  - "He suffered death and was buried..."

- "One, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church..."
- **4. Visual Elements (10 points):** Add symbols or drawings that represent the key truths of the Creed (e.g., the Trinity, the cross, the Church, the dove, etc.).
- **5.** Faith Reflection (15 points) Write a short reflection (3–5 sentences):
  - What part of the Creed do you find most powerful or inspiring?
  - Why do we say the Creed at Mass?
  - How does this help you grow in your faith?
- **6. Memorization Practice (10 points): Begin memorizing** the full Nicene Creed over the summer.

You will be asked to **recite or write it from memory** during the first weeks of school. To prepare:

- Read the Creed out loud regularly.
- Copy it by hand once a week.
- Pray it during Sunday Mass.

You don't need to include the full text on your one-pager—but keep practicing!

7. Neatness, Creativity & Effort (10 points)

Make your page neat, colorful, organized, and thoughtful. Use your best effort.
