"How m' I doin?"

One of the more colorful public figures I admired in public life was Ed Koch, mayor of New York City from 1978-1989. He had a way of winning you over, regardless of your political affiliation. His trademark "how m' I doin?" cut through partisanship and always yielded an immediate thumbs up or down from a happy or disgruntled constituent. Hizzoner solicited people's comments long before aspiring corporate execs were flocking to 360 degree feedback seminars to enhance their bottom line. Headstrong and iron willed with his staff, Koch really seemed to listen to the voice of the guy on the street.

The turning of the year gives us an opportunity to take stock of "how we're doin" relative to our living the gospel - building a balance sheet of plusses, minuses and question marks. Using Matthew 25 as our base, we have a short list of simple, doable gospel-driven actions we can measure ourselves against. Here we go, starting from the top - how well did we feed the hungry and quench the thirsty? Did we pitch in during our Thanksgiving drive to struggling families in Paterson or our canned goods collections to our local Long Valley food bank? Did we remember to drop off a case of life-saving water from Memorial Day through Labor Day for our annual summer homeless outreach campaign? Did we clothe the naked by filling a backpack with new warm clothing for our veterans, men and women still on the street? How well did we welcome strangers to our land, invite the new comer or outcast, the one a bit different from ourselves by culture, language, age or race? What about letting our representatives know that we are a people of welcome and not exclusion? Were we able to make a visit to someone who passes time, day after lonely day, without visitors at a nursing home, shelter or hospital. Were we able to read a favorite book, singing a well worn comfortable song or just being the "sacrament of presence" to him or her, quietly reassuring that someone still cares?

That's the sum total of the gospel - to be Christ to others, especially those most in need. We'll all score differently, that's to be expected. Some have the means, the time, and the wherewithal to fill a checklist with all affirmative marks. Some not so much but take heart, Jesus said "feed my lambs" not count them. Whatever turns up for you , accept it, take it deep into your heart and let your inner stillness guide you in this new year. We are reassured that WE are the Body of Christ and each of us DO make a difference in the world we inhabit during these short span of days we are given. Squander not a moment of it. And as our elders teach us, "do all the good you can, in all the ways you can, in all the places you can, to all the people you can, for as long as you ever can." To this we say AMEN!



First Reading: Isaiah 8:23-9:3

The prophet Isaiah describes the anguish of a conquered people, but he promises that they will triumph and will see a great light as on the "day of Midian."

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:10—13, 17

Paul speaks to the Corinthians with both anger and indignation because they are quarreling among themselves as to whom they should show allegiance. Some wish to follow Paul; some, Peter; others Apollos; others, Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 4:12-23

Jesus begins his mission by going to Capernaum, fulfilling the prophecy of Isaiah. He selects Peter, Andrew, James and John as his disciples, inviting them to be "fishers of men."
