Memorial Day, formerly known as *Decoration Day*, commemorates U.S. military Veterans who have paid the ultimate price for their service to our nation. First enacted to honor Union and Confederate soldiers following the Civil War, it was extended after World War I to honor Americans who have died in all wars. We usually see the holiday as the kick off of the summer season and often forget the deeper significance and solemnity that it originally held. A scan on the Internet led me to an expansive list of the military interventions the US has played a role in. The list was sobering!

Which do you remember?

Colonial wars (1620-1774), War of Independence (1775-1783), Continental expansion (1816-1860), American Civil War (1861-1865), Indian Wars (1865-1870), Spanish-American War (1898), Philippine-American War (1899-1913), Banana Wars (1898-1935), World War I (1917-1918), World War II (1939-1945), Korean War, Lebanon crisis of 1958, Vietnam War, Grenada, Beirut, Panama, Gulf War, Somalia, Yugoslavia, Afghanistan, Iraq. Add up all the men and women who've died in these wars and conflicts over the last 230+ years along with the covert and overt operations such as Grenada, Panama, Mogadishu and the Balkans and you end up with a tally of 1,346,000 + men and women who've given their lives to protect the freedoms and interests of United States of America.

Let us honor all our Veterans, those in our memories, and those still with us as we pray: Dearest Lord, comfort all our Veterans who have been injured or who have become ill while serving our country, whether in war or in peacetime. Please look out for their families so they do not lose their homes, their hope, their trust in their fellow man and their way in life. Please help those Veterans and their families to overcome any adversity they face as they struggle to build lives whole again, day

by day, and find it in your heart to grant them every benefit they are entitled to receive. Please Lord, guide all those who work to support our Veterans and their families. Show them the way to do 'what's right'. Give them the strength never to act in any way unjust or unfair. Give them compassion and patience to understand that many Veterans suffer in ways that we may never understand. Give them the strength to do what is best for all men and women who have given a part of their lives for the freedoms we enjoy. Gather to yourself, Lord, our fallen brothers and sisters who gave themselves totally in the service of our Nation. Teach us, Lord, that we are all of one human family and we are all in this together. Teach us to see our common bond and collective responsibilities we owe to each other. Give us the grace to embrace our differences and celebrate our connections, and send us out on our life's journey "to seek peace and pursue it" in all that we do, through Christ – our Prince of Peace, now and forever. Amen.
