




REFLECTION OF THE WEEK



July 27, 2025
17th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Luke 11:1-13

Once I went to a hospice facility to celebrate Last Rites for an elderly dying man. His family had told me that he had been uncommunicative for days. At the conclusion of the ritual, we began to recite the Our Father prayer. To everyone's surprise, his lips moved, clearly mouthing the words to the Lord's prayer. Stripped of most of his faculties, the man could still pray those precious God-given petitions. A lifetime of prayer had planted the words even deeper than his failing consciousness.

Do we want the Lord's prayer to be as deeply embedded in us? If we want to be people of hope, we should. Recall that our Lord immediately follows the prayer by saying: **"Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you"** (Luke 11:9). We only ask, search and knock because we hope that the request is not in vain. Everything we could possibly hope for is contained in the prayer. Praying the Our Father deepens our hope.

We should consciously pour all our hopes into the Lord's prayer; we should allow it to be an expression of hope, not simply rote words. Then, over time, it builds up our hope in God. It sinks deep into our souls and bodies. How blessed we are when these words of hope are on our lips, even when everything else seems to fail.




JUBILEE 2025 PILGRIMS OF HOPE

Holy Rosary Parish is a designated pilgrimage site for the 2025 Jubilee year. The Holy Father has granted a plenary indulgence to all those who make a pilgrimage to one of these sites, attends Mass, and receives the sacrament of confession around that time (<https://www.ncregister.com/news/jubilee-2025-indulgences>).

To aid Catholics in attaining this indulgence, our council and parish are hosting a Rosary procession and pilgrimage titled '1000 Roses for Mary' on **Saturday, August 23. Pilgrims are asked to gather at 9:45 AM at St Rose of Lima parish in Portland (2727 NE 54th Ave, Portland, OR 97213) and walk 2.5 miles to Holy Rosary Parish (375 NE Clackamas Street, Portland, OR 97232). Mass and Confessions will follow. After Mass, the council will be providing a lunch and a bus will shuttle pilgrims back to St Rose of Lima.**

To encourage pilgrims, we are collecting donations to fill our church with *one thousand Roses* in honor of the Blessed Mother. Pilgrims are asked to donate \$5 per rose. Extra funds will go towards Knights charita-

Community/Spiritual CONNECTIONS



St. Alphonsus Liguori—St. Alphonsus Liguori, (1696-1787) was born in Marianella, near Naples, in Italy. When he was young, he displayed exceptional intelligence and piety, earning a doctorate in civil and canon law by the age of 16. Feeling a calling to dedicate his life to God and the service of others, however, he abandoned his legal career and pursued ordination to the priesthood. He was ordained at the age of 30 in 1726.

Throughout his priestly ministry, Liguori focused on preaching missions and retreats, seeking to renew people's faith and draw them closer to the Eucharist. He frequently preached on the real presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and encouraged frequent reception of Holy Communion as a source of spiritual nourishment and

grace.

In 1732, Liguori founded the Redemptorists, a religious congregation dedicated to promoting devotion to the Eucharist and the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Redemptorists' charism also revolved around reaching out to the most abandoned, including the poor and marginalized, and offering them hope through God's love and mercy.

As a prolific writer, Liguori authored numerous works on moral theology, spirituality, and Eucharistic devotion. His most famous work, "The Glories of Mary," remains a classic in Marian theology and devotion. He is remembered for his practical and merciful counsel, always seeking to lead souls to reconciliation, and union with God.

St. Alphonsus was canonized as a saint in 1839 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1871. His spiritual writings, particularly on the Eucharist, continue to inspire and guide the faithful worldwide. As the patron saint of moral theologians, his example reminds believers of the profound love and presence of Christ in the Eucharist and the enduring mercy of God. St. Alphonsus Liguori, pray for us!
