



A WORD FROM FR. IVAN

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

St. Bernards will be offering one possible means, during Lent, to rediscovery what it means to be Christian, through a catechesis given by a team of catechists from the parish. The catechesis will begin Monday March 26 at 7pm. The timing of the catechesis is to be in the midst of Lent so it may help you to enter into the Lenten spirit.



A catechesis is an announcement of Jesus Christ, and his victory over sin and death. The catechists, accompanied by your parish priests, will not come only as speakers, but as witnesses to God's power. They will announce how he has worked amazingly in their lives. You are encouraged to attend these CATECHESIS FOR ADULTS AND YOUNG PEOPLE (12 years and over). The catechesis will be held every Monday and Thursday at 7:00 PM in the grade school building starting on February 26. Each catechesis extends for about one hour and all are asked to "Come and listen."

Please mark your calendar to keep these nights free for the next several weeks. There is no charge, and free child care is available. The thing that is required of you is your presence, to listen and let God speak to you.

Members of the team of catechists will speak briefly at next weekend's Masses in order to extend an invitation to the Catechesis. In the coming days, some parishioners will, with my permission, visit homes in the neighborhood in order to extend the same invitation to those who for some reason were not present at Sunday Mass.

As your pastor, I feel it is my moral obligation to provide means for all of us to seriously encounter the love of God which gives us the possibility to overcome our fears and anxieties. I am convinced that the upcoming catechesis will address just that. Jesus will be passing through this catechesis. I hope to see you there, and invite others especially those who have been away from the church and need to hear the word of God.

Here are the church regulations for fasting and abstinence during Lent:

- Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent* and Good Friday.
- Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

Please consider extending your pledge payments by one year. If we can get close to the remaining balance pledged then we can go forward with having both bell towers repaired.




