



Last year we have started a partnership with Ramsey County Human Services. Two financial assistance workers are coming in our Parish Center every Tuesdays from 8:30am—12:30pm to help the Karenni community with county and MNSure paperwork. These workers were able to assist and average of 35 families every Tuesday. Our staff provided the interpretation needed.

Also so far our Karenni Outreach has received over \$54,000 in fundraising. This money is coming from these different resources: The Archbishop, Mission Appeal, Sunday envelopes, St. Casmir and the Franciscans Brothers.
